PRESENTATIONS

Vaya Health Update

Brian Ingraham, CEO, and Larry Hill, CFO, stepped through their PowerPoint presentation and explained the climate of the company during the COVID-19 pandemic. The company is prioritizing network stabilization efforts to address the most at-risk areas first. Buncombe County provides \$600K Maintenance of Effort (MOE) funds to support prevention, treatment and crisis services for those who have mental health, substance use disorders, and/or intellectual/developmental disabilities.

• FY2021 Recommended Budget

Avril Pinder, County Manager, gave a detailed overview of the FY2021 Budget and explained how the Strategic Plan is supported through deliberate funding. A public hearing for the budget will be held at the June 16th meeting and budget adoption will follow or will be considered at a special meeting on June 23rd.

NEW BUSINESS

• Federal Home and Community Care Block Grant (HCCBG)

Stoney Blevins, Health & Human Services Director, explained that the grant is for support services for our aging Population community with a partnership with Land of Sky Regional Council. Currently, the Board of Commissioners is the lead agency but there is a request for Human & Health Services to be the lead agency.

Commissioner Belcher moved to approve the recommended HCCBG and county aging fund allocations for SFY 21. Commissioner Edwards seconded and the motion passed 6-0.

Commissioner Edwards moved to grant HCCBG lead agency status to Buncombe County HHS for SFY 21. Commissioner Whitesides seconded and the motion passed 6-0.

Rate Adjustment for Purchased Transportation Services Provided Under the Transportation Agreement between County of Buncombe and City of Asheville

Matt Cable, Planning Manager, explained the agenda item and stated that the rate adjustment would streamline the Billing rate to a single rate of \$2.28 per shared service mile for all services and eliminate the administrative surcharge. The rate adjustment will provide cost savings to the City and impact the subsidy provided by the County.

Commissioner Belcher moved to approve the rate adjustment and eliminate the ten percent (10%) Administrative surcharge effective July 1, 2020. Commissioner Beach-Ferrara seconded and the motion passed 6-0.

Resolution Authorizing the Execution of Subordination Agreements and other Acts Related to the East Haven Project

Brandon Freeman, Staff Attorney, explained the resolution and the time sensitivity of the agenda item.

Commissioner Beach-Ferrara moved to approve the resolution as presented. Commissioner Edwards seconded And the motion passed 6-0.
