COVID-19 Update Presentation with FAQs

• One Buncombe, COVID-19 Rapid Relief Fund

Tim Love, Business Officer and Phillip Hardin, Health and Human Services, explained that the One Buncombe, COVID-19 Rapid Relief Fund was created in April 2020 and the Community banded together to raised nearly \$1.4M for individuals and small businesses. The pandemic has continued to stress the Community and the need to assist individuals and small businesses is critical. The Board will determine the need for the additional funding for the individual direct assistance programs at a required public hearing.
