Farm Preservation Successes



COMBE COUNTY

- ✓ 20 Family Farms Protected2,777.71 acres
- Raised over \$4 million in grant funding
- ✓ Raised over \$11 million in charitable donations since 2005



Agricultural Community Successes

- Created the national award winning
 Farm Heritage Trail
- ✓ Voluntary Agricultural Districts:
 287 farms totaling 20,708 acres
- Enhance Voluntary Agricultural Districts: 14 farms totaling 1,867 acres







Proactive Planning

- Completed Buncombe Farmland Protection Plan 2020 adopted Aug 2020
- GIS Project generating Farmland Community Prioritization to focus conservation efforts
- MPA Research project identifying potential ongoing funding sources for conservation
- Supporting the BC 2025 Strategic Plan Goal
 - Environmental and Energy Stewardship: Preserve Farmland and Environmentally Sensitive Tracts



Challenges



COMBE COUNTY

- Limited county staffing
- Limited transaction cost funding
- Limited easement purchase funding
- Limited number of grant applications allowed per entity
- 38 farms totaling in 3,226 acres still on Farmland Preservation waiting list

Strategic Opportunity

\$750,000 annual investment through FY26:

- Anticipate **<u>18 projects</u>** initiated annually
- Approximately **70 projects** initiated by 2025
- Additional <u>6000 acres</u> of important farmland and environmentally sensitive tracts conserved

FY21 Funding Level: \$240,000

- \$120,000 for Ag Advisory Board easements
- \$120,000 for Land conservation Advisory Board easements
