Continuing Operations and Maintenance Budget

- ➤ After asking for no increase last year, we are requesting a 2.8 percent increase from the County budget.
- ➤ Due to under-expense as the result of reduced in-person operations during this COVID year, we project our Buncombe County Cash Reserve to grow by \$140K to \$523K as of June 30, 2021.
- Our budget increase will cover an anticipated pay increase for county employees to match a state increase and increased expenses for insurance and utilities as we resume full-operations post COVID-19.

- We will continue to be frugal, because we anticipate continuing operating efficiencies due to:
 - Ongoing schedule of capital repairs and replacements funded by Article 46.
 - Energy savings from 7,000 lamp fixture replacements with LEDs, funded by Article 46.
 - Eventual energy savings resulting from and paying for the installation of solar panel arrays on seven campus buildings, and as well as savings from the restoration of passive solar units for domestic hot water.
 - > Energy management module tied into our work order system.
 - State-certified energy manager on staff.
 - Ongoing Spyglass monitoring of all telecommunication expenses.
