WHEREAS, in Buncombe County there are over 340 children and youth in foster care—care that provides a safe, secure, and stable temporary home until permanent housing is identified; and

WHEREAS, foster families in Buncombe County open their homes and hearts to children whose families are in crisis and play a vital role in helping children and families heal, reconnect, and launch children into successful adulthood; and

WHEREAS, foster families are essential to the foundation of our communities and perform an extraordinary service by working in partnership with agencies and families to nurture children and provide an opportunity for healthy growth and development.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:
