## RESOLUTION OPPOSING PROPOSED CHANGES FOR ELECTIONS TO THE BUNCOMBE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD BY DISTRICT

WHEREAS,	the Buncombe County School Administrative Unit (sometimes herein "Buncombe County Schools") includes 44 schools and serves over 22,000 students;		
WHEREAS,	the Buncombe County Schools system is governed by an elected Buncombe County Board of Education comprised of seven members, six of whom must live in each of the six various districts (Enka District, Roberson District, Erwin District, Reynolds District, Owen District and the North Buncombe District) within the larger Buncombe County School Administrative District and with one member serving atlarge;		
WHEREAS,	public education is one of the most vital functions of local community governance;		
WHEREAS,	the taxpayers of Buncombe County invest more of their local taxes into public education than any other public service or infrastructure;		
WHEREAS,	for many decades all of the qualified voters who live within the Buncombe County School Administrative Unit have been able vote for all of the candidates for membership on the Buncombe County Board of Education at large regardless of the district within which the voters reside, creating accountability for decision making and investment of taxpayer dollars; and		
WHEREAS,	the Buncombe County Board of Education has not requested a change of elections which would restrict the ability of voters to only vote for two of the seven positions on the school board.		
NOW, follows:	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Com	missioners of Buncombe County, North Carolina, as	
1.	That the Buncombe County Board of Commissioners formally oppose the proposed legislation that would restrict the ability of citizens in Buncombe County to vote for all the candidates running for the Buncombe County Board of Education.		
2.	That copy of this Resolution be forwarded members of our legislative local delegation, leaders of the North Carolina General Assembly, and the Office of the Governor.
