

# The Guarantee


85% guarantee up to a max guarantee of \$70,000

A few examples:


	Borrower A	Borrower B	Borrower C

# Current Request

\$1.5M to expand this vital loan guarantee facility to drive an inclusive economic recovery:

- 90 loans made totaling \$3.4M
- 320 jobs created/retained
- \$4.8M in match and leverage funds
