Parks & Recreation enhances and improves resident's quality of life through Health and Wellness and connection to, preservation of the Natural Environment.

Investments in Parks & Recreation is an investment in the social, emotional and physical well-being of our community.



History of CIP & Maintenance

Lack of a comprehensive planning process for CIP (Capital Investment Program) for Parks & Recreation

- Level of care was restricted to basic maintenance
- Projects were planned on an annual basis
- · Lack of focus on long-term planning

High level of Deferred Maintenance

- Maintenance was not performed as scheduled or as needed due to limited resources or other County-wide priorities
- Aging infrastructure and amenities in disrepair struggle to deliver the benefits of parks and recreation to all members of the community.
 - · Lack of Park amenity and beautification standards





Results

Facilities fall into disrepair and become exponentially more expensive to repair often requiring major renovations that are more costly.

Results

- Deteriorating facilities with unsafe conditions
- · Deferred maintenance and repairs backlog
- Unkept parks with unsafe and mis-matched amenities
- Poor visitor experience and perception of Buncombe County Parks & Recreation Department


- Comprehensive Inventory of Park Facilities, Greenways and Recreation Services

Equity Matrix

Buncombe County Parks and Recreation is developing a set of equity-based criteria for prioritizing capital investment and large rehabilitation projects.
