Family Justice Center – Governor’s Crime Commission

Purpose of Grant: Ensuring integrated, trauma-informed service provision to serve survivors of intimate partner violence, sexual assault, elder and child abuse.

Term of Grant: January 2016 – September 2023

FY24 Request: \$468,000 in new County funding for nine months of FY24.
Full year cost would be \$624,000.



Jail & Prison Reentry Grant

Purpose of Grant: Provides community-based services for those released from the jail including peer support, case management services, and linkage to care for those with chronic physical health conditions, mental health conditions and substance use disorders

Term of Grant: November 2020 – March 2023

FY24 Request: \$310,000 in new County funding for FY24.



Dept. of Justice COPS Grant

Purpose of Grant: Strengthen investigation units by addressing threats to public safety in Illegal Guns Reduction And Narcotics Team (IGRANT formerly BCAT) & CID-ARSON in Enforcement Division; recruitment, hiring practices and performance monitoring, focus orientation towards problem solving in areas served by officers & ongoing community engagement; and sustain currently recognized Arson Investigation Program within BCSO Enforcement/CID to build partnership with local law enforcement agencies

Term of Grant: August 2020 – June 2023

FY24 Request: \$297,000 in new County funding for FY24 for three positions.



Mobile Medication Assisted Treatment Team Grant

Purpose of Grant: To provide Community Paramedic Post-Overdose Response Team and Medication for Opioid Use Disorder (MOUD) teams with peer support workers and wraparound care.

Term of Grant: November 2021 - January 2023

FY24 Request: \$207,000 in new County funding for FY24.



Behavioral Health Planning Grant (DHT)

Goal of Grant: Support Buncombe County in planning for opioid settlement funding by supporting staff costs for a behavioral health manager and behavioral health analyst as well as technology and materials costs associated with the planning activities.

Term of Grant: November 2021 – December 2023

FY24 Request: \$135,000 in new County funding for 6 months of FY24 for two positions. Full year cost would be \$270,000.



Communicable Disease & Infection Prevention Mobile Team

Purpose of Grant:

- Partner with our community increasing equitable access to public health services, focusing on those historically underserved by the healthcare system, low-income areas and rural communities
- Increase uptake of preventative health services and connections to social supports and services.

Term of Grant: March 2022 – May 2023

Request: \$725,000 in new County funding for FY24 for six positions.



Safer Together Grant

Purpose of Grant: Coordinate a public health approach to the opioid epidemic through strategic stakeholder collaborations for a population-level response and intervention.

Term of Grant: October 2019 – September 2023

FY24 Request:

- HHS - **\$274,000** to fund one position as well as contracted services for nine months of FY24
- Emergency Services - **\$187,000** in new County funding for nine months of FY24.

Full year costs approximately \$615,000



Adult Protective Services (APS) Essential Services Grant

Purpose of Grant: Provide and arrange for essential needs on behalf of a minimum of 10 clients to include:

- Provision of medical care for physical and mental health
- Assistance with personal hygiene, obtaining appropriate food, clothing, seeking and providing heated and ventilated shelter
- Providing for protection from health and safety hazards, abuse, neglect, and exploitation.

Term of Grant: February 2022 – December 2022

FY24 Request: \$35,000 in new County funding for FY24.
