#### **Continuing Operations and Maintenance Budget**

- ➤ We are requesting a \$1,225,374 increase from the County.
- This increase will cover a 5% pay increase for county employees to match an anticipated state increase, restoration of a 1% underwrite of state payroll with the goal of returning to the historical 8% underwrite prior to 2015-16, and increased expenses for utilities.
- > Our cash reserve will be spent down from \$909K to \$150K.
