RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ASHEVILLE AND THE COUNTY OF BUNCOMBE REGARDING A FOOD SCRAP DROP-OFF PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, Buncombe County and the City of Asheville plan to enter into an initiative to co-manage a Food Scraps Drop-Off program;
- WHEREAS, the program will provide food scraps drop-off sites to the public free of charge, with food scraps drop-off sites located within city limits and outside city limits to serve both city and county residents;
- WHEREAS, an Interlocal agreement is required for local governments to enter into such a mutual undertaking;
- WHEREAS, pursuant to GS 160A-461 a city and county may enter into agreements with each other in order to execute any undertaking as ratified by resolution of the governing board of each unit of government;
- WHEREAS, per City Council Resolution No. 23-95 signed on May 9, 2023, City Council authorized the City Manager to enter into this Interlocal Agreement; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners is of the opinion that it is in the best interest of the parties involved to enter into this Interlocal Agreement with the City of Asheville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR THE COUNTY OF BUNCOMBE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the County Manager is hereby authorized to execute the attached Interlocal Agreement between the City of Asheville and the County of Buncombe.
2. That this Resolution shall be upon its adoption.
