Current Grant Eligibility

- Nonprofits in active operation for a minimum of 2 years
- Projects that meet a public purpose and align with County Strategic Plan (Education, Environment, Well-Being, Economy)
- Funding limited to no more than 3 years for a single project
- Funding limited to less than 30% of organization's annual operating budget







Highlights

Process Improvement Discussions

- Request additional funding from Board of Commissioners to increase the Strategic Partnerships Grant fund
- Implement hard cap of \$80,000 on request amounts
- Explore how to better assess geographic and demographic impact within the county
- Consider "bonus" scoring for things like smallness, newness, innovation, and lean budgets
- Improve categorization of project applications and grants



Next Steps

- Staff is working with grantees on funding agreements
- Performance reports published online quarterly
- Committee site visits to funded projects
- Plan for next grant cycle (process improvement)
