








FY24-FY28 CIP



FY24-28 CIP - Potential Debt Service



*Note: Potential debt service above consists of estimated debt service from FY24-FY28 General Fund CIP projects as well as currently adopted GO bond projects, which total \$14.9M. Estimates assume debt issuance a year after project adoption at a 5% interest rate and a term of 20 years.
