RESOLUTION NO. 2023-01

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE SALARY OF THE DIRECTOR OF BUNCOMBE ELECTION SERVICES TO THE BUNCOMBE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

- WHEREAS, pursuant to North Carolina General Statute section 163-35, compensation paid to Directors of Elections in all counties maintaining full-time registration (five days per week) shall be in the form of a salary in an amount recommended by the county Board of Elections; and
- WHEREAS, the Buncombe County Board of Elections has received information from the Buncombe County Human Resources Department, the North Carolina School of Government, and from the human resources departments of Cumberland, Durham, New Hanover and Union counties regarding Election Directors' salaries, as detailed in Exhibit A; and
- WHEREAS, the Board's recommendation is commensurate with the salaries paid to Election Directors in counties similarly situated and similar in population and number of registered voters; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Elections is prepared to make a salary recommendation for the Director of Buncombe County Election Services for the 2023-24 fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Buncombe County Board of Elections as follows:

- That the Board of Elections recommends that the Director's salary be \$107,186.13 per annum prior to the issuance of any cost-of-living adjustment awarded by Buncombe County on July 1, 2023.
- 2. That this Resolution be forwarded to the Buncombe County Commissioners for final action.
- 3. That this Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
