Ordinance Amendment Goals

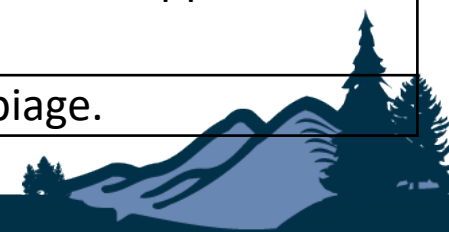
Solid Waste Ordinance

- Remove process specifics better left for franchise contracts.
- Removes redundancies already existing within General Statute.
- Adjusts verbiage to prevent conflicting language between ordinance and future franchise contracts.
- Allows for flexibility in future franchise contracts based on evolving County/residential needs.
- Allow fee adjustments through franchise agreement rather than Board action to amend the Ordinance.
- Simplifies the ordinance.



Ordinance Changes

CHANGE TYPE	DIFFERENCE	REASONING
Definition clarification	Changing definition for “detachable or roll off container” to “roll cart” – also defines what a roll-cart container is.	Roll cart is correct verbiage moving forward, removing all definitions and references that state otherwise.
Definition clarification	Defining “Dumpster”	Updating document for proper verbiage.
Definition clarification	Changes all references from “Households, commercial establishments or small industries” to “residential property.”	Clarification and simplification.
Definition clarification	Defining “Person”	“Person” now refers to all customer types, bodies, and other legal entities.
Reference to G.S.	“Refuse” definition removes word “rubbish” and directs definition to General Statute.	Clarifies section through G.S. rather than word “rubbish.”
Reference to G.S.	Removes “Sec. 62-29” associated with penalties for violations of article.	Removes redundancies already in G.S. and leaves penalties negotiable per contract to allow for future flexibility without board approval to update ordinance
Definition clarification	Updates all definitions from Sec. 62-26.	Adjusted for conflicting verbiage.
