- To defend the State, its people, and their constitutional rights.




NCDOJ Update Funds Collected – Buncombe County

- Opioid settlement: \$32 Million
- Funds won for Consumer: \$176,500
- Medicaid fraud: \$42,000
- Taxpayer funds won and grants: \$462,000
- Total Funds returned: \$32.7 million

NCDOJ Wins Affecting Citizens

1. Juul

 \$40 million for NC and commitments to modify their practices with young people

2. Dish Network

• \$14 million settlement for illegal robocalls in NC; money to public schools

3. Duke Energy

Coal Ash Cleanup – Saving NC customers \$1.1 billion

4. Google Lawsuits

- \$17 million for NC in 2022 (largest multistate privacy settlement)
- Part of \$700M settlement based on Google's conduct with Google Play Store
