Where It Began

"Meaningful Access" as defined by the U.S. Department of Justice is language assistance that results in accurate, timely, and effective communication at no cost to the individual with LEP needing assistance.

How we got here

In early 2023, in partnership with Poder Emma, CAPE applied for and received a \$25,000 grant offered through the Institute for the Study of the Americas (ISA) and the Building Integrated Communities Initiative (BIC) at UNC Chapel Hill.

The Language Access Collaborative was launched.



How We Evolved

During our year+ long commitment to the Collaborative, our team participated in in-person language access summits and monthly virtual workshops and completed regularly assigned activities.

The ultimate objective of the Collaborative was to produce and implement a Language Access
Plan for the County.




Our goal now is to implement the County's first Language Access Plan.

The partnership that the Buncombe team formed with members of Poder Emma bolstered our understanding that Community must come first and that, to move forward, we must work together.




Survey/Interviews


Poder Emma participants suggested that we survey departments in person.
