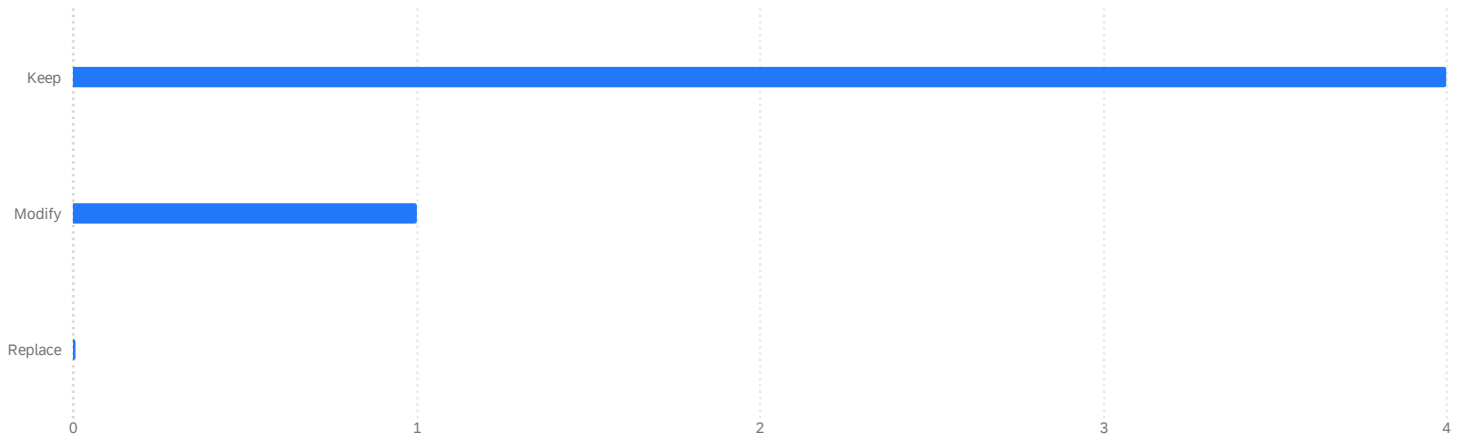

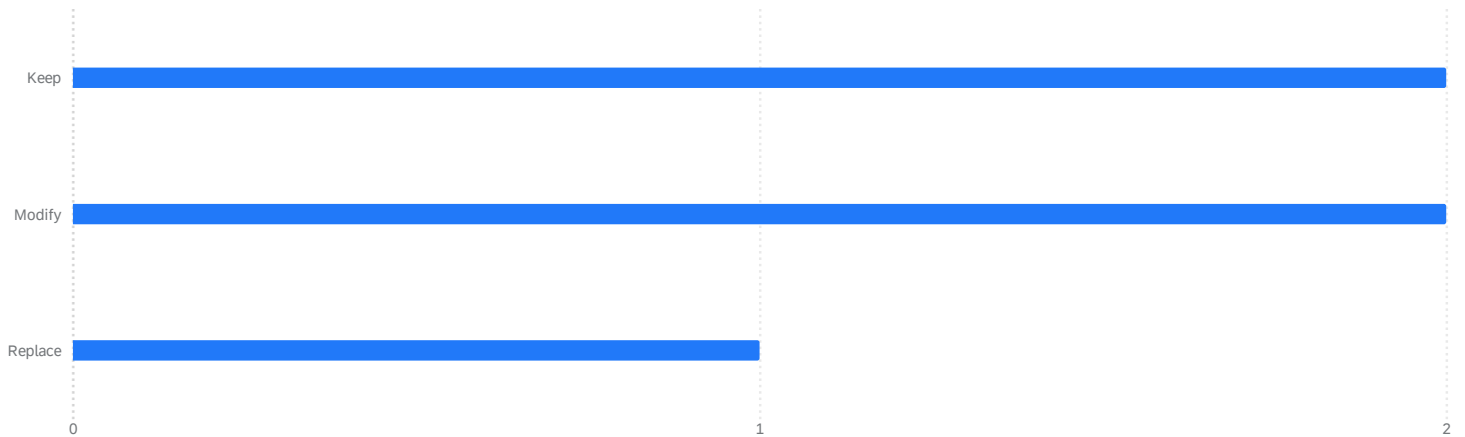

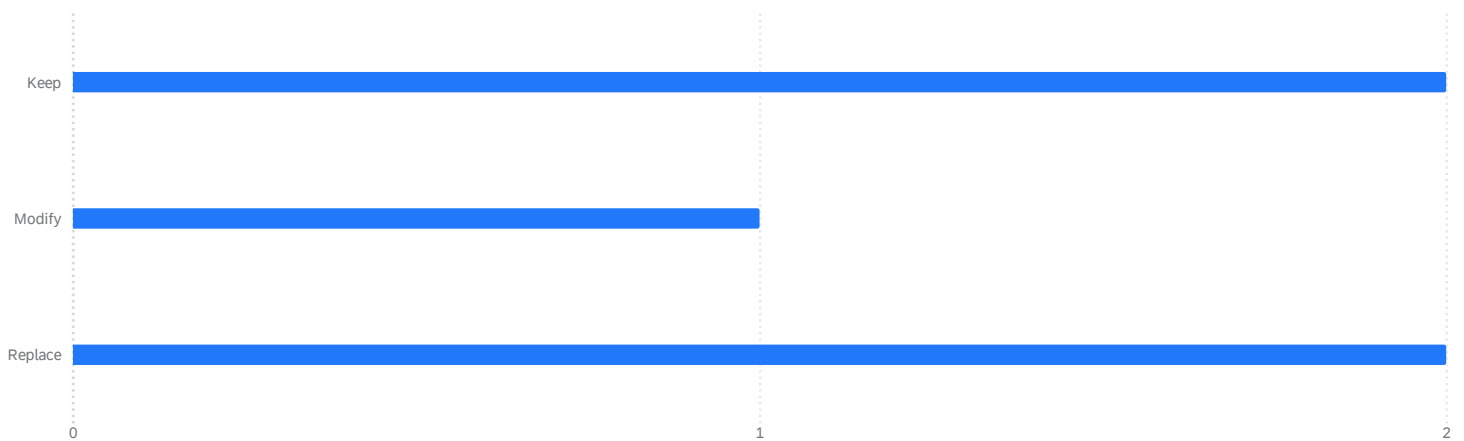

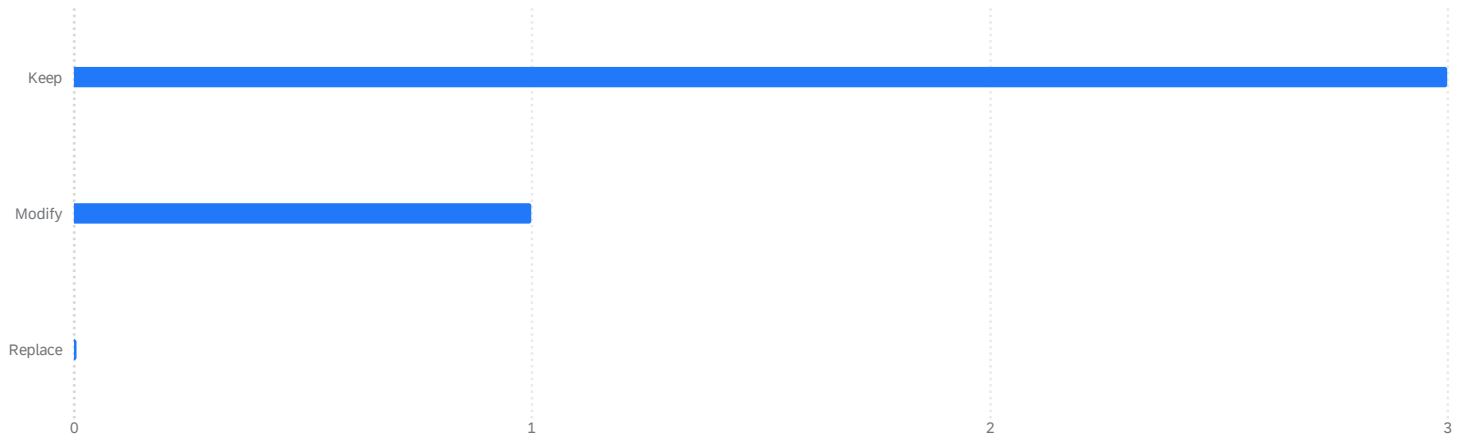

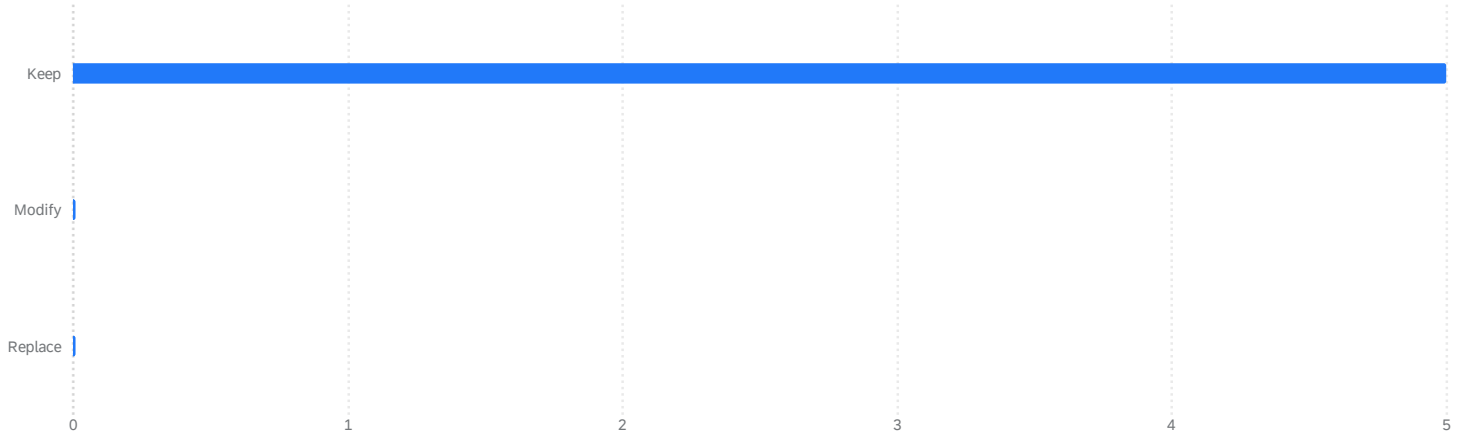

This is a goal that directly impacts our local economy and the ability to earn a living wage. We must partner with the K-12 schools and A-B Tech to determine how we best support them with this goal.

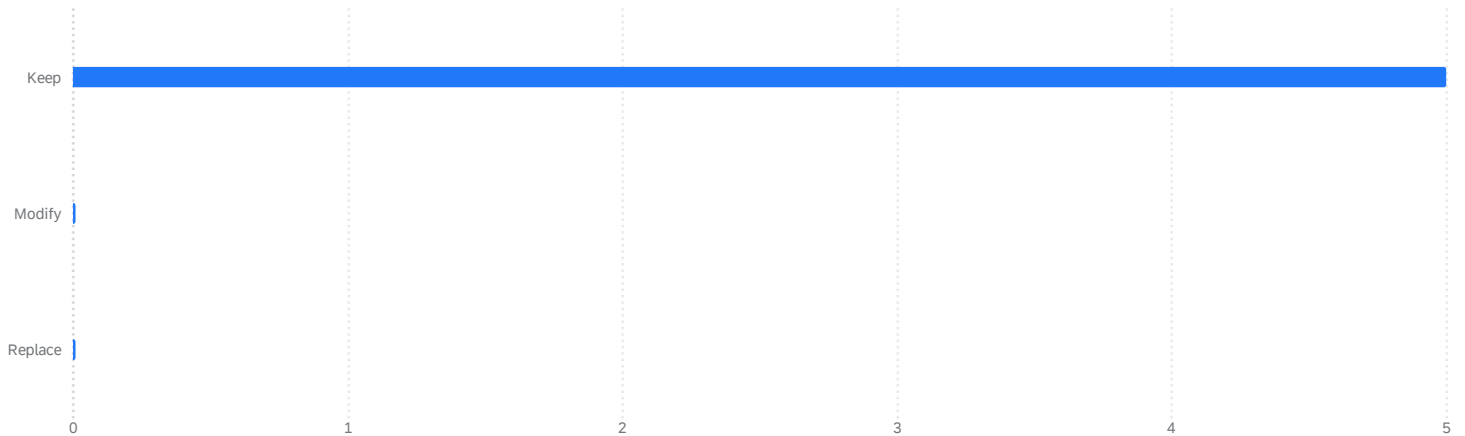

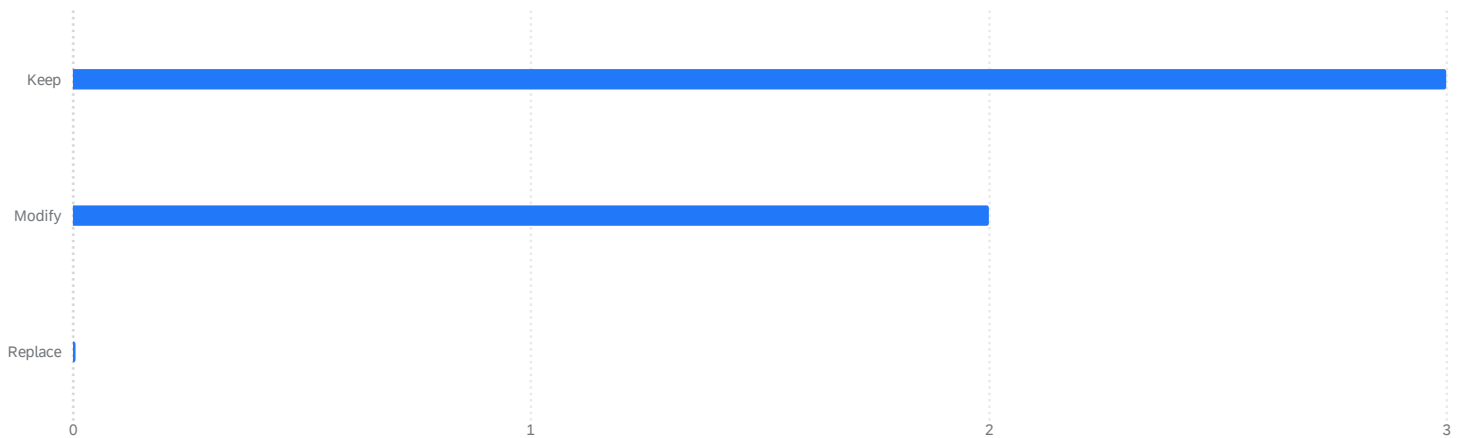

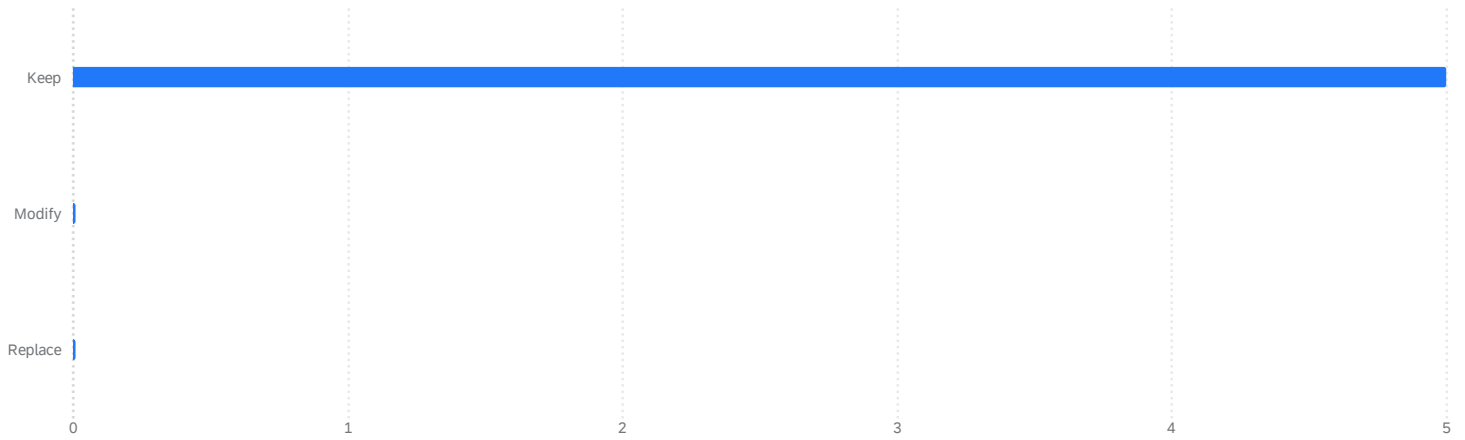

we may want to consider alternative language to include consideration of some innovative approaches to mobility options in light of new technologies and business models for mobility.

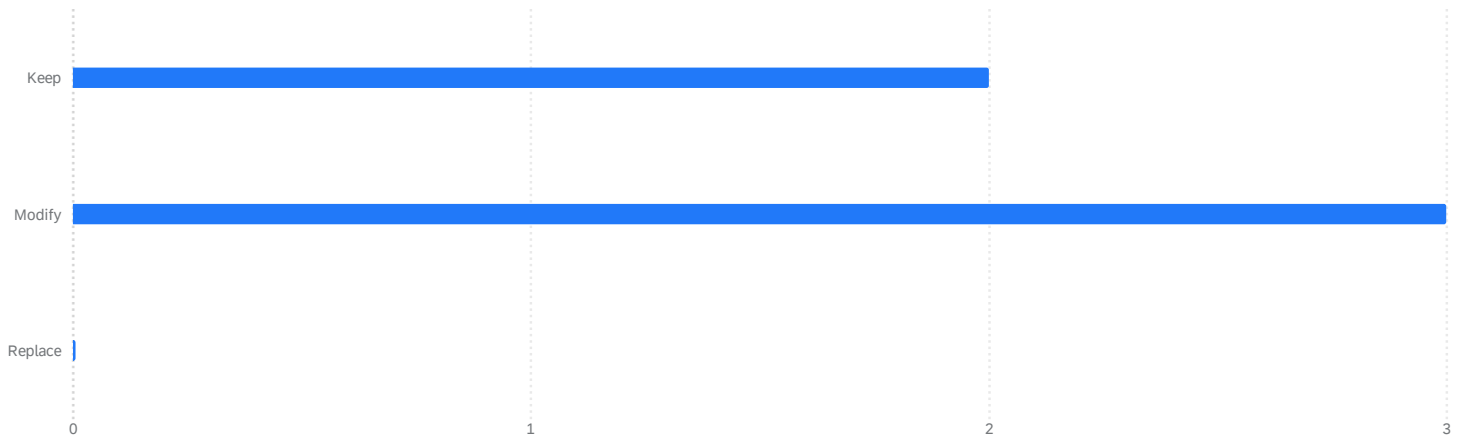

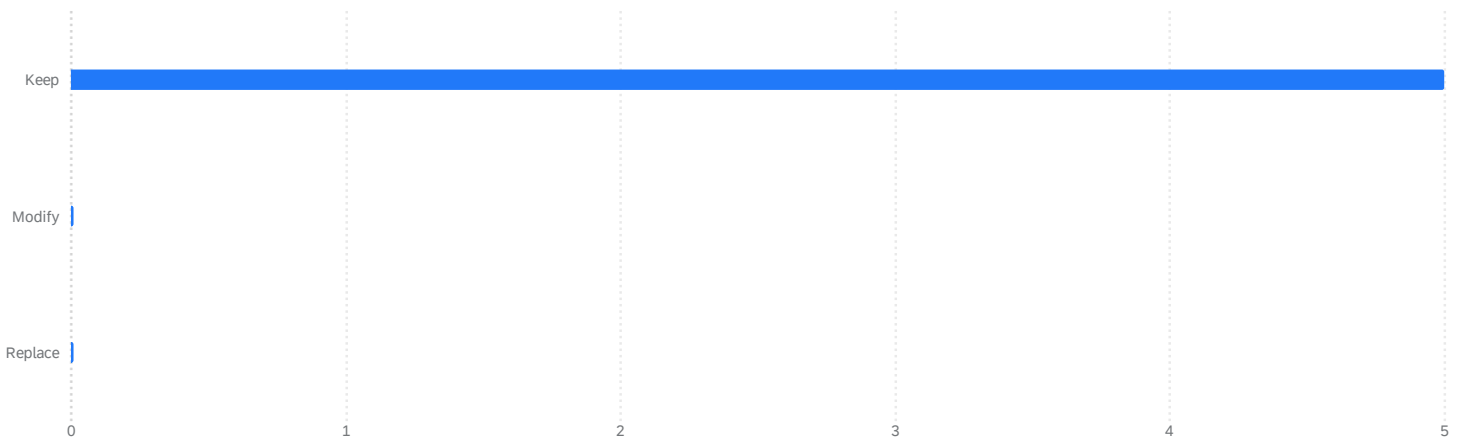

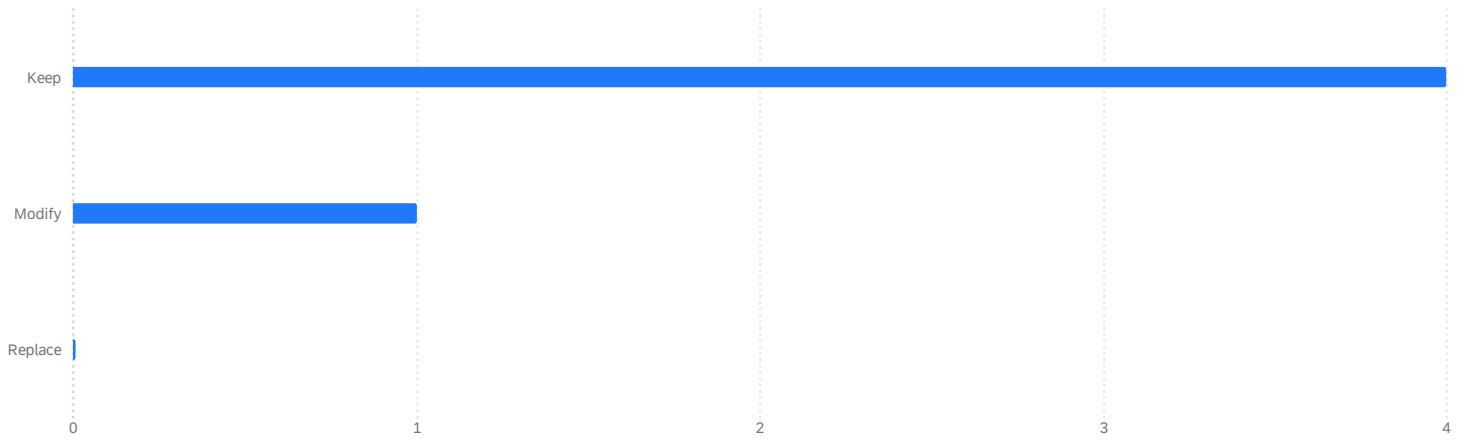

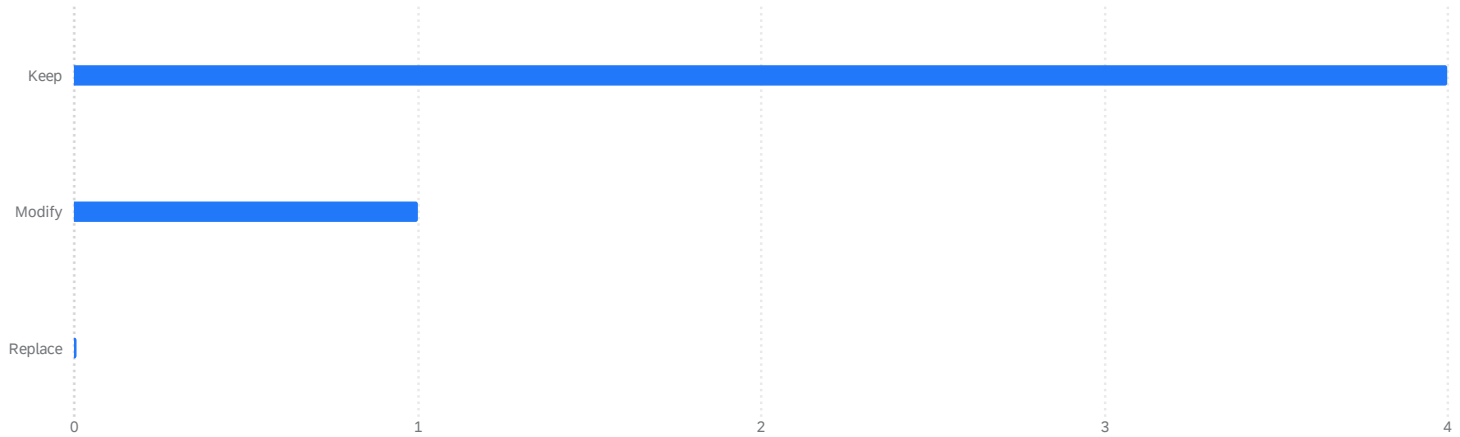
