A CMS coming soon! But what is it?


- Allows you to create, manage, and publish digital content without coding knowledge
- Multiple team members can manage content in a CMS and make updates in real-time
- Handles all back-end and front-end coding
- Staff can focus on producing content and creating an engaging user interface (UI) and user experience (UX)
- Staff can easily add videos, images, social media through modules
- Easily adapts for mobile usage

Q7. Percentage of Respondents That Use Various Sources of Information to Learn About County News, Events, and Other




by percentage of respondents (multiple choices could be selected)

ADA Compliance

Title II of the ADA requires state and local governments to make sure that their services, programs, and activities are accessible to people with disabilities.

Applies to all services, programs, or activities of state and local governments, from adoption services to zoning regulation, including those offered online and through mobile apps.

Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) assist users who:

• Have learning disabilities


