

Bright Stripes Textured Scarf

Sweet and simple! This scarf is perfect for adding a stripy pop of color to your wardrobe. It knits up in a striping pattern so you don't have to worry about weaving in extra ends when you're finished! Scarf measures 7" [18 cm] wide x 72" [183 cm] long

SCARF

Cast on 25 stitches.

Row 1 (Right Side): K1, *p1, k1; repeat

from * across.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): P1 *k1, p1; repeat from * across.

Row 3: Repeat Row 2.

Row 4: Repeat Row 1.

Repeat Rows 1-4 until piece measures

72" from cast on edge.

Bind off all sts.

Finishing

Weave in all ends.


Fringe

Cut yarn into ninety 10" [25.5 cm] lengths. Hold 5 strands of yarn together and fold in half forming a loop at one end. *Insert crochet hook into corner of one short edge of scarf and place loop on hook. Draw loop through, insert ends through loop and pull to tighten; repeat from * to attach a total of 9 fringes evenly across edge. Repeat for other short edge of scarf. Trim fringe evenly.

Goal Line Chunky Scarf

The Broken Rib pattern adds interest to the enjoyable automatic striping of this yarn. The chunky weight gives this knit scarf a more modern look and extra coziness. It's perfect for cheering on your personal MVP.

Scarf measures: 7" wide x 70" long [18 cm x 178 cm]

Broken Rib Pattern

Row 1 (Right Side): *K3, p1; repeat from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): K1, *p1, k3: repeat

from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Repeat Rows 1-2 for Broken Rib Pattern.

SCARF

Cast on 19 sts.

Next Rows (Right Side): Work Rows 1-2 of Broken Rib Pattern until scarf measures 70" [178 cm] from cast on edge.

Next Row: Bind off all stitches loosely.

FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave in ends.

Snazzy Striped Scarf

Choose any of the unique self-striping colors of this soft yarn for an ultra-easy design. We've made it extra long so it can be wrapped around twice—so wonderfully cozy!

Scarf measures 7%" x 80" [19 x 203 cm], excluding fringe.

SCARF

Ch 24.

Row 1 (right side): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (beginning skipped ch do not count as a st), hdc in each ch across, turn-22 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 1, (sc. 2 dc) in first hdc, *skip next 2 hdc, (sc, 2 dc) in next st; repeat from * 5 times, skip next 2 hdc, sc in last hdc; leave beginning ch unworked. turn-8 sc and 14 dc.

Row 3: Ch 2 (does not count as a st). hdc in each st across, turn-22 hdc. Rows 4-149: Repeat last 2 rows 73 Fasten off.

FINISHING

Cut 88 strands, each 10" (25.5 cm) long. For each fringe, hold 2 strands together and fold in half to form a loop. Insert hook from right side in first stitch of Row I. Place fold on hook and draw fold through, forming a loop. Thread ends of strands through loop and pull to tighten. Repeat to attach fringe in every stitch across both short edges of scarf. Trim ends evenly.

Simple Style Hat

As always, Unforgettable yarn knits up beautifully. The stitch pattern is created by alternating stripes of knit and purl rounds, making this hat perfectly slouchy. Directions are for size Small; changes for sizes Medium and Large are in parentheses.

Hat circumference: 18 (20, 22)" [46 (51, 56) cm].

NOTE: Hat is worked holding 2 strands of yarn throughout.

HAT

Cast on 72 (80, 88) sts. Place marker to join in the round, being careful not to twist sts.

Rounds 1-5: Knit,

Rounds 6-10: "K2, P2; repeat from * around.

Rounds 11-13: Purl, Rounds 14-16: Knit.

Repeat Rounds 11 - 16 until work measures 5" (13 cm) from cast on edge, ending with Round 13.

Crown

Round 1: *K6, k2tog; repeat from * around - 63 (70, 77) sts.

Rounds 2-3: Knit. Rounds 4-6: Purl.

Round 7: *K5, k2tog; repeat from *

around - 54 (60, 66) sts.

Rounds 8-12: Repeat Rounds 2-6.
Round 13: *K4, k2tog; repeat from *

around - 45 (50, 55) sts.

Rounds 14-18: Repeat Rounds 2-6, Round 19: *K3, k2tog; repeat from *

around - 36 (40, 44) sts.

Rounds 20-21: Knit. Rounds 22-24: Purl.

Rounds 25-27: Knit.

Rounds 28-33: Repeat Rounds 22-27.

Rounds 34-35: Purl.

Round 36: 'K2tog; repeat from ' around - 18 (20, 22) sts.

FINISHING

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Using yarn needle, draw through remaining stitches. Draw up firmly; fasten securely. Weave in all loose ends.



Directions are for Women's size; changes for Men's size are in parentheses.

Finished Circumference: 19% (22%)" (49.5 (57) cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes Finished Height: 9 (10)" (23 (25.5) cm)

Notes

- 1. Hat is worked in joined rounds beginning at the top and changing color to create
- 2. Change color when working joining slip stitch at the end of a round as follows: Complete last stitch of round (1 loop remains on hook). Insert hook in top of beginning ch-2. Drop old color to wrong side (inside) of hat. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete joining slip stitch. Proceed with new color. Do not cut old color. Carry color not in use carefully up wrong side of hat when next needed.
- 3. Hat can be worked using A and B as directed or by reversing the colors,

HAT

With A, ch 2.

Round 1 (right side): Work 7 (8) sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st in first sc--7

Round 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc here and throughout), hdc in same sc as joining slip st, 2 hdc in next 6 (7) sc; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2-14 (16) hdc. Round 3: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next st, [2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st] 6 (7) times; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2-21 (24) hdc.

Round 4: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next 2 sts, [2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts] 6 (7) times; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2-28 (32) hdc.

Round 5: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next 3 sts, [2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts] 6 (7) times; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2-35 (40) hdc.

Round 6: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next 4 sts, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 4 sts] 6 (7) times; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2-42 (48) hdc.

Round 7: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next 5 sts. [2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 5 sts] 6 (7) times; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2-49 (56) hdc.

Next 1 (2) Rounds: Ch 2, skip same st as joining, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2 and change to B Next 2 Rounds: With B, ch 2, skip same st as joining, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2 and change to A at end of 2nd round.

Next 4 Rounds: With A, ch 2, skip same st as joining, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2 and change to B at end of 4th round.

Next 2 Rounds: With B, ch 2, skip same st as joining, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-2 and change to A at end of 2nd round.

Repeat last 6 rounds to work one more stripe with A and one more stripe with B. Fasten off.



Round 12: With right side facing, draw up a loop of A in same st as joining, ch 2, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off A.

Rounds 13 and 14: With right side facing, draw up a loop of B in same st as joining, ch 2, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off B.

Round 15: With right side facing, draw up a loop of A in same st as joining, ch 2, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Do not fasten off A.





Cool Stripes Beanie

Choose any of the cool shades of yarn to make the perfect striped beanie for yourself or to give. This style crochets quickly thanks to the soft bulky weight yarn. Hat measures 20 (22)" (51 (56) cm) circumference

Notes

- Hat is worked in joined rounds beginning at the top of the hat.
- The chain-2 beginning chain of each half double crochet (hdc) round counts as the first stitch.
- 3. When changing color, you can fasten off the old color as instructed. Alternately, to reduce the number of ends to weave in later, keep the old color attached and bring it carefully up the inside of the hat when next needed.

HAT

Round 1 (right side): With A ch 3, work 11 hdc in 3rd ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first hdc); join with slip st in top of beginning ch—12 hdc.

Round 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc here and throughout), hdc in same st as joining (increase made), 2 hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—24 hdc.

Round 3: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next st, *2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—36 hdc.

Round 4: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in each of next 2 sts, *2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 2 sts; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—48 hdc.

20" Circumference Only

Rounds 5–7: Ch 2, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off A. Round 8: With right side facing, draw up a loop of B in same st as joining, ch 2, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off B.

Round 9: With right side facing, draw up a loop of A in same st as joining, ch 2, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off A.

Round 10: With right side facing, draw up a loop of **C** in same st as joining, ch 2, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off **C**.

Round 11: With right side facing, draw up a loop of A in same st as joining, ch 2, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off A.

Round 12: With right side facing, draw up a loop of B in same st as joining, ch 2, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off B.

Round 13: With right side facing, draw up a loop of **A** in same st as joining, ch 2, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Do not fasten off **A**.

Round 14: Ch 1, TURN, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

22" Circumference Only

Round 5: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in each of next 7 sts, *2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 7 sts; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—54 hdc.

Round 6: Ch 2, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch.

Fasten off A.

Rounds 7 and 8: With right side facing, draw up a loop of **B** in same st as joining, ch 2, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off **B**.

Round 9: With right side facing, draw up a loop of A in same st as joining, ch 2, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off A.

Granny Stitch Hat

There are many reasons to love this hat; It is modern looking in thick yarn. It' crochets up quickly. It is a very easy pattern that is good for television watching. The style looks good on most everyone. It's a great gift choice.

Directions are for size Small. Changes for size Large are in parentheses.

Hat measures 20 (22½)" [\$1 (57) cm] circumference at brim.

Special Technique

Adjustable-ring method = Wrap yarn into a ring, ensuring that the tail falls behind the working yarn. Grip ring and tail firmly between middle finger and thumb. Insert hook through center of ring, yarn over (with working yarn) and draw up a loop. Work stitches of first round in ring, working over both strands (the tail and the ring). After the first round of stitches is worked, pull gently, but firmly, on tail to tighten ring.

Notes

- Hat is worked in joined rounds with right side facing,
- To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

HAT

With A, make an adjustable ring.

Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 8 (9) dc in ring; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—9 (10) dc. Pull gently on tail to close ring.

Round 2: Ch 3, dc in same st as join, 2 dc in each dc around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—18 (20) dc.

Round 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, 'dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc; repeat from around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch; change to B—27 (30) dc.

Size Small only: Round 4: Ch 3, dc in same st as join, skip

next dc, *2 dc in next dc, skip next dc; repeat from * around to last dc, dc in last dc; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-13 two-dc groups and 1 dc. Rounds 5 and 6: Slip st in next dc, slip st in space before next 2-dc group, ch 3, dc in same space, *2 dc in next space between 2-dc groups; repeat from * 11 times, 2 dc in space before last dc, dc in space between last dc and beginning ch; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Round 7: Slip st in next dc; change to A, slip st in space before next 2-dc group, ch 3, dc in same space, *2 dc in next space between 2-dc groups; repeat from 11 times, 2 dc in space before last dc. dc in space between last do and beginning ch; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off.

Size Large only:

Round 4: Ch 3, dc in same st as join, skip next dc, *2 dc in next dc, skip next dc; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—15 two-2 dc groups.

Rounds 5-7: Slip st in next dc, slip st in space before next 2-dc group, ch 3. dc in same space, 2 dc in each space between 2-dc groups around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch.
Round 8: Slip st in next dc; change to A, slip st in space before next 2-dc group.



Keep Warm Beanie

Crochet a beanie that will keep you warm and looking great at the same time! This yarn is extra thick and comes in wonderful color shadings. Post stitches are used to form the ribbed edging.

Directions are for size small; changes for large are in parentheses

Hat measures 20 (22)" [51 (56) cm] in circumference

NOTES

- 1. Ch 3 at beginning of a round counts
- 2. Hat is worked in the round with RS always facing.
- 3. When working dc sts into the beginning ring, work over the yarn tail. Then, after a few rounds, pull the tail end tight to close the ring and avoid a hole in the center.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Front Post Double Crochet (fpdc):

Insert hook from front to back to front around the post of the corresponding stitch below, yarn over and pull up a loop, varn over and pull through 2 loops twice to finish the dc.

Back Post Double Crochet (bpdc):

Insert hook from back to front to back around the post of the corresponding stitch below, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice to finish the dc.

HAT

Ch 4, join with slip st in first ch to form

Round 1 (right side): Ch 3, 9 dc in ring, join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3 - 10 dc.

Round 2: Ch 3, dc in same st as joining slip st, 2 dc in each dc around, join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3 - 20 dc. Round 3: Ch 3, dc in same st as joining slip st, dc in next dc, * 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * around, join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3 - 30 dc.



For smaller size only:

Round 4: Ch 3, dc in same st as joining slip st, dc in each of next 4 dc, * 2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 4 dc; repeat from * around, join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3 - 36 dc.

For larger size only:

Round 4: Ch 3, dc in same st, dc in each of next 2 dc, * 2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 2 dc; repeat from * around, join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3 - 40 dc.

For both sizes:

Rounds 5-10: Ch 3, skip first st, dc in next dc and in each dc around, join with slip st in top of beginning ch 3. Round 11: Ch 2 (counts as first bpdc), fodc around next dc, * bpdc around next dc, fpdc around next dc; repeat from around, join with slip st in top ch of



HAT

Cast on 80 sts. Join into the round, being careful not to twist sts. and place marker at beginning of round.

Round 1: *Knit 2, purl 2; repeat from * to end.

Work in Knit 2, Purl 2 ribbing until hat measures 10"

(25 cm) from cast on.

Shape Crown

Note: Change to double pointed needles when work is too small for circular needle.

Round 1: *Knit 2, purl 2 together (dec 1 st); repeat from * to end - 60 sts.

Rounds 2-4: *Knit 2, purl 1; repeat from * to end.

Round 5: "K2tog, purl 1; repeat from " to end - 40 sts.

Round 6: *Knit 1, purl 1; repeat from * to end.
Round 7: *K2tog; repeat from * to end - 20 sts.

Round 8: Knit.

Round 9: *K2tog; repeat from * to end - 10 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail.

FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave yarn through remaining sts; gather sts up firmly and secure. To wear, fold brim up.

Stitch marker, yarn needle

GAUGE: 13 sts = 4" [10 cm]: 19 rounds = 4" [10 cm] in Slip Rib Stitch Pattern (unstretched). CHECK YOUR GAUGE, Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

Slipped Rib Hat

This hat knits up in no time with super-bulky Evermore. You may find yourself making one in every color!

Hat Adult Medium (Large) Circumference at bottom edge (unstretched): 20 (23)" [51 (58) cm] Circumference at bottom edge (stretched): 23½ (25)" [58.5 (63.5) cm]

Length: 9½ (9½)" [24 (24) cm]

NOTE

Slip 1 as if to purl with yarn in back.

STITCH PATTERN Slip Rib Stitch

Round 1: *K1, slip 1, k1, p2; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 2: *K3, p2; repeat from * to end of round.

Repeat Rounds 1-2 for Slip Rib Stitch.

HAT

Using Circular Knitting Needles, cast on 65 (75) stitches. Join being careful not to twist stitches and place stitch marker for beginning of round.

Begin Slip Rib Stitch and work until piece measures 7½ (7½)" [19 (19) cm] from cast on edge; end after a Round 2.

SHAPE CROWN

(As number of stitches decreases, change to Double-Pointed Needles).

Round 1: *K3, p2tog; repeat from * to end of round - 52 (60) sts.

Round 2: *K1, slip 1, k1, p1; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 3: *K1, k2tog, p1; repeat from * to end of round - 39 (45) sts.

Round 4: *Slip 1, k1, pass slipped stitch over, p1; repeat from * to end of round. -26 (30) sts.

Round 5: K1, K2tog to last st, k1 - 14 (16)

Round 6: *K1, p1; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 7: K2tog around - 7 (8) sts.

Round 8 (size 20 only): K2tog to last st,

Round 8 (size 231/2 only): K2tog to end of round - 4 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a tail 12" [30 cm] long. Draw through remaining stitches twice, fasten securely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4" (10 cm); 22 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Stockinette st. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Free-Spirited Hat

This thick-and-thin yarn has wonderful shadings and interesting texture. You'll love knitting and wearing this hat made with our new version of Unforgettable yarn!

Directions are for size adult small; changes for large are in parentheses.

Hat measures 19 (21)" (48 (53.5) cm) in circumference.

SPECIAL STITCHES

M1 (Make 1) = Increase 1 st by picking up the strand between sts, twisting it into a loop, and knitting it.

HAT

Cast on 72 (80) sts.

Row 1: * K1, p1; repeat from * to end.

Repeat this row until piece measures 2"
(5 cm).

Next row (increase row, right side): K9 (10), M1, * k18 (20), M1; repeat from ` 3 more times, k9 (10) ~ 76 (84) sts.

Work evenly in Stockinette st until piece measures 9 (10)" (23 (25.5) cm), ending with a wrong side row.

Next row (dec row, right side): * K2tog; repeat from * to end - 38 (42) sts.
Cut yarn, leaving an 18" (45.5 cm) tail.
Use yarn needle to weave tail through all remaining sts, and pull tight.

FINISHING

Sew seam. Weave in all loose ends.

dec = decrease; inc = increase; k = knit;
k2tog = knit next 2 sts together; p =
purl; st(s) = stitch(es); * or ** = repeat
