 - Note: Guidestar.org requires user registration; basic search capacity is free of charge.

- Community impact and the ability to meet client needs: What accomplishment in the past year are you most proud of?
- Any desired or planned expansion of services and the existence of resources for it.
- Partnerships with other social service non-profits and government agencies.
- Greatest challenges to the organization as a going concern.
- Comments, suggestions or recommendations for the HCCBG Advisory Committee.

Clients:

- Sourcing: word of mouth, marketing, referrals from other organizations, self-referrals, other.
- Challenges in service delivery.
