RESOLUTION SUPPORTING NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION US 70  
ROADWAY AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) is considering improvements to US 70 to accommodate the relocation of the Ingles warehouse driveway, private railroad crossing to a location out of and to the west side of the Norfolk Southern in Black Mountain, Buncombe County; and

WHEREAS, the relocation of this crossing will allow it to be signalized, making it safer for both the large trucks entering US 70 and the motorists on the road; and

WHEREAS, the relocation of the crossing is part of the Ingle's Warehouse Expansion project which will create 175 new jobs; and

WHEREAS, this Board is of the opinion that support of this project would be in the best interest of the citizens of this County; and.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:

1. This Board does hereby support the NCDOT US 70 roadway and safety improvements to accommodate the Ingles Warehouse Expansion project.
2. This Board requests that the NCDOT keep the Commissioners informed on the status of this project.
3. That this resolution be effective upon its adoption.
