
# Jim's Branch

- 122 acres, Swannanoa
- Requesting \$51,650: \$27,650 for transaction costs, \$24,000 bargain purchase
- Estimated easement value \$430,045
- Landowners willing to donate 94% of value
- In conservation focus area
- Recommended by the Land Conservation Advisory Board
- Visible from I-40
- Extends up to an elevation of 3,700 feet
- Includes 8 headwater creeks


#### Jim's Branch Tract


- 122 acres


# Little Pisgah Mountain

- 506 acres, Fairview
- Requesting \$395,000: \$67,500 for transaction costs, \$327,500 bargain purchase
- In conservation focus area
- Recommended by the Land Conservation Advisory Board
- 100 acres of high elevation pasture and 405 acres of working forest lands
- Contains the largest exposed open grassy ridge on Little Pisgah Mountain, extensive rock outcrops, and potential archaeology sites

#### Little Pisgah Mountain Conservation Easement Tracts




- Visible from Drovers Road Scenic Byway, Blue Ridge Parkway, Bearwallow Mountain across Hickory Nut Gorge, and more
- 100 acres high elevation pasture + 405 acres working forest land
- 2 existing homes. Reserve 5 new homesites plus 2 new guest houses
- Nearly touching 700-acre Florence Preserve
- Adjacent to 126-acre Brown CE, and 90 acres owned by The Nature Conservancy
- Over 22,000 linear feet of buffered headwater streams flowing into Garren Creek and Cane Creek





# Camp Woodson

- 235 acres, Broad River
- Requesting \$502,000
- Estimated easement value \$2,195,200
- Pisgah Center operates the Woodson Wilderness Challenge, wants to purchase Camp Woodson to continue, and possibly expand, the center that educates and counsels adjudicated youth
- Recommended by the Land Conservation Advisory Board
- 15,000 feet of ridgelines
- Over 15,800 feet of streams

Aerial Map of Camp Woodson Conservation Plan, 235 acres for Conservation








#### Bearwallow Mountain

- 14.5 acres, Fairview
- Buncombe & Henderson Counties (part of > 200 acre easement)
- Requesting \$41,830, \$13,000 transaction costs, \$28,830 bargain purchase
- In conservation focus area
- Recommended by the Land Conservation Advisory Board
- Bearwallow Mountain is visible from Mount Mitchell, Chimney Rock State Park, Mount Pisgah, Blue Ridge Parkway and Drovers Road Scenic By-way






#### Bearwallow Mountain: Phase II Contextual Map

Locations, Boundaries, and Areas Approximate








#### Drovers Road

- Recommended by the Agricultural Advisory Board and the Land Conservation Advisory Board
- Productive bottomland farms along the Drovers Road Scenic By-way









### Kirstein

- In progress, Broad River

- 307 acre farm in the Kirstein Family since the 1700s
- In conservation focus area
- Scenic pasture land supporting a large cattle herd
- Healthy rich forests with chestnut oaks, yellow poplar, red maple and numerous indigenous plant and animal species




#### Kirstein Easement 307 Acres




### Merschat





# Brown Easement 230 Acres








