WHEREAS,	that this Board is of the opinion that it is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the County to authorize this acquisition.	
WHEREAS,	Public Safety and Information Technology staff are of the opinion that this cost is fair and reasonable and that this tower location should take care of these needs of the County for many years to come.	
WHEREAS,	Incombe County is interested in purchasing a 1.5 acres portion of the property owned by SASSAFRAS ALLEY, LLC as is generally depicted on the attached map of the property in the area of "Point 2" ereinafter sometimes "Premises") for use as a Public Safety Communications Tower site for the sum of hirty-Five Thousand and 00/100 U.S. Dollars (\$35,000.00). The terms and conditions of the transaction e more particularly set forth in the Purchase and Sale Agreement dated December 28, 2011.	
WHEREAS,	SASSAFRAS VALLEY, LLC, a North Carolina Limited Liability Company, owns certain real property located in Buncombe County, North Carolina and being a portion of the property set forth and described in deed recorded in Book 4486, Page 1881 Buncombe County, North Carolina Registry and identified on the Buncombe County tax records as Parcel: 9699-28-6790.
