Vulnerable Adults and Elder Abuse Awareness Month

- WHEREAS, Buncombe County's seniors deserve to live safely with dignity; and vulnerable and older adults of all socio-economic, racial and ethnic backgrounds WHEREAS, may be targets of abuse, neglect or exploitation which occurs in families, long term care facilities and communities; and WHEREAS. elder abuse is most often defined as any act that harms a senior or jeopardizes his or her health or welfare; and WHEREAS, in 2011 more than 19, 553 reports of abuse, neglect or exploitation of vulnerable and older adults were made to North Carolina's 100 County Departments of Social Services; and WHEREAS, protecting Buncombe County's vulnerable and older adults is a community responsibility and it is imperative that communities work together to help reduce
- WHEREAS, in 2030, 1 in 4 North Carolinians will be over the age of 60; and

and prevent abuse, neglect and exploitation; and

- **WHEREAS**, all residents should watch for signs of abuse such as physical trauma, withdrawal, depression, anxiety, fear of family members, friends or caregivers.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED** by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:
 - 1. That this Board does hereby proclaim June 2012 as:

Vulnerable Adults and Elder Abuse Awareness Month

in Buncombe County.

- 2. That this Board does here by encourage all citizens to participate in community efforts to support and improve the safety and well-being of vulnerable and older adults and secure their right to live free of abuse, neglect and exploitation.
- 3. That this proclamation be effective upon its adoption.
