

RESOLUTION DONATING SURPLUS LOW BAND RADIO EQUIPMENT TO BUNCOMBE COUNTY SCHOOLS

- WHEREAS, a request has been made from Buncombe County Schools for donation of surplus, low band radio equipment for use in their school bus garage; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. 153A-176 and N.C. Gen. Stat. § 160A-280, the County may transfer to a nonprofit organization incorporated by one of the United States personal property that the governing board determines to be surplus, obsolete or unused; and
- WHEREAS, Buncombe County Schools is a North Carolina nonprofit corporation organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of North Carolina; and
- WHEREAS, the County has surplus, low band radio equipment formerly used for emergency responders and law enforcement and the County Information Technology Director and Purchasing Agent recommend that said equipment be donated to the County School for use by their garage; and
- WHEREAS, this Board believes the donation of the surplus equipment will aid the County Schools their work for the community; and
- WHEREAS, this Board is of the opinion that it is in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the County that this resolution be adopted.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:

1. That surplus, low band radio equipment identified by the County Information Technology Department and Purchasing Agent be declared surplus property.
2. That the donation of said equipment to Buncombe County Schools be and is hereby approved and accepted.
3. This resolution be effective upon adoption.
