## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ASSIGNMENT OF BID

- 2. By and with the approval of the County Attorney, the Chairman and County Manager, or either of them, are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to do any and all other acts and to execute any and all other documents, which they, in their discretion, deem necessary and appropriate in order to consummate the transaction contemplated by this Resolution; except that none of the above shall be authorized or empowered to do anything or execute any document which is in contravention, in any way, of the specific provisions of this Resolution.
- 3. That this resolution be effective upon its adoption.
