Background information

The North Carolina Division of Public Health (DPH) was awarded Community Transformation Grant (CTG) funding to implement policy, systems and environmental changes that support tobacco free living, active living, healthy eating and high impact evidence-based clinical preventive services over a five-year period. DPH is funding ten multi-county Collaboratives, which align with the regional structure currently used by the North Carolina Association of Local Health Directors to implement strategies locally. Funding for CTG is authorized through the Affordable Care Act 2010.

Our multi-county collaborative (Region 2) includes Avery, Buncombe, Burke, Caldwell, Henderson, Madison, McDowell, Mitchell, Polk, Rutherford and Yancey Counties.
