Background information

Buncombe County constructed the Public Safety Training Center facility for training law enforcement, fire service, emergency medical services, hazardous materials emergency response teams, and other rescue and emergency personnel. The next phase is related to the design and construction of a 40,990 square-foot facility for educational classrooms and offices to be constructed onsite at the training center. The classroom will be operated through the Law Enforcement Academy at Asheville-Buncombe Technical Community College.

Construction bids were received on April 16, 2013. The architects for the project recommend that the Board award a contract to the low bidder, Hickory Construction, in the total amount of \$5,701,715, as described in the architect's recommendation and bid tab.
