How the Funds Were Used

Land of Sky Regional Council (LOSRC) provided household assistance through its Connecting All Communities internet access & digital literacy assistance project. LOSRC partnered with Housing Authority of the City of Asheville (HACA) to increase internet access for low-income residents through WIFI installations in public housing communities. LOSRC also hired a Digital Navigation Coordinator to perform digital literacy community outreach. The project intended to provide affordable WIFI to 6 HACA public housing sites, serving roughly 700 residents and support digital literacy to 300 residents, to include mainly senior, homeless, BIPOC, low-income, and rural populations.

Results

808 households served
90 individuals received WIFI at HACA

1,123 individuals received digital literacy support
