Narrative summary of grant related activities

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Overall project updates: COVID-19 impacts:	We currently have 119 students enrolled. Our school age program closed on 4/2/2021 as the public schools transitioned to in person learning. As with most businesses, we are experiencing difficulty in hiring qualified staff members. Our annual inspection, was completed and we retained our 5 star license. ELP graduated 36 students this year. Our kids will be spread out over 3 counties and 12 different elementary school. We served 27 different school age families during the pandemic when face to face instruction was not possible by licensing our multipurpose room for occupancy by children. Students ages 3 to 5 returned to receiving weekly swim instruction in April. Our students also completed a 10 month art program using the Root and Wings Little Wings Pre-K creative cultivation curriculm. The "Little Wings" curriculum focuess on the process by exploring meaningful early childhood experiences through the creative exploration using art. During this quarter, ELP continued to POD. Podding provided time for extra cleaning of high touch surfaces, toy washing and meeting additional sanitizing requirements. Since 6/7/21, Parents have been allowed to enter the building and drop students off at the classroom door. No one but teachers and students are allowed in the classroom space at this time. Temperature scans and health questions are recorded daily using our ProCare parent engagement tool. The YWCA is following the most up to date interim guidance from the NC Department of Health and Human Services using the Public Health Toolkit.
Activities related to increasing equity, diversity and inclusion:	ELP staff members are working to increase diversity, equity and inculsive activities into their classroom instruction. Teachers are intitally focusing on buliding community. Starting with our fall term August 23, 2021, ELP will teaching an anti-bias curriculum created by the YWCA Minneapolis Early Childhood Education Department. Teachers received training in conscious discipline, mindfulness and resiliency to help families deal with the effects of the pandemic.
Activities related to increasing operational excellence:	ELP is utilizing Procare software for data collection. In June, we switched our parent engagement tool from Kidsreports to the ProCare parent engagement tool. Parents have been pleased with this new software. We continue to participate in Teaching Strategies Gold and developmental assessments using Brigance III or Ages and Stages. We use Conscious Discipline; Resilience tools and Mindfulness activites to enhance the social/emotional aspects of our program. The upper hall is providing Literacy (4-5 year olds) and Art instruction (3-5 year olds) and weekly swim lesson (3-5 years).
