## Narrative summary of grant related activities

The James Vester Miller Historic Trail Church Exhibit was to allow the community to have the opportunity to step inside 4 Historic Black Churches, view the craftmanship inside and out, ask questions & learn local history. Having doshens from the individual churches available to assist with questions was a great way to interact with the patrons.
