## Narrative summary of grant related activities

LEAF Global Arts served 370 students with the Tipping Point grant funds and the survey outcomes are strong. Youth engaged with professionally-trainined and highly-experienced Resident Teaching Artists in visual arts with Kelsey Moseley, Edwin Salas, Tiffany DeBelotte and Eli Hamilton, movement with Irvegg Romero-Gallegos and Joe Adams (breakdancing/hip-hop), Heena Patel (Indian Folk Dancing), Monika Guerra (Latin dance) and Molly Graves (theater), and music with Adama Dembele (Africa drumming), Irvegg Romero-Gallegos (Latin drumming), McKinney and Andre Lassalle (guitar), Nik Hope and Ary'an Graham (drumline). One challenge we had is lack of transportation staff from community partners to bring students to LEAF Global. One community partner expressed that they had trouble finding CDL drivers with flexible schedules who are willing to help transport youth during Teacher Work Days and holiday day camps.
