## Narrative summary of grant related activities

While we have yet to spend our funding on park infrastructure, we have been hard at work managing the invasive plant species on the property. We recently met with an arborist who will be removing the dead standing Tree-of-Heaven on site as well as other dead trees and limbs on January 24th, 2024, creating a safer space for the public to utilize. Once the trees are removed, we will quickly begin installing the park elements outlined in the contract.

We will be leading community volunteers in invasive plant removal at Florida Ave. while also inviting feedback from the community on what they would like to see at the park.
