Where do I file?

- Notice of Candidacy will be completed at the office. Candidates do not need to bring this form. If you will not be filing in person, please email victoria.pickens@buncombecounty.org.

What are the qualifications?

- Must be a registered voter of the county.
- Where there is a district, must also reside within that district. Municipal offices: must reside within the municipality.
- **Sheriff:** must submit a disclosure statement prepared by the **North Carolina Sheriff's Education and Training Standards Commission**. The statement is valid for 90 days after issuance and must be submitted at the time of filing for office.
- NC Senate: must be an NC resident for 2 years by 11/8/2022 within the district for 1 year by 11/8/2022.
- NC House: must be a resident within the district for 1 year by 11/8/2022.
- Must be registered with a NC recognized political party for at least 90 days at the time of filing your Notice of Candidacy.
- Must be at least 21 years old on Election Day (NC Senate: 25 years old).

What do I need to bring?

- A valid NC driver's license or photo ID, payment method for filing fee cash (\$50.00 and under), check, cashier's check, or money order, and any completed campaign finance documents.
