July 5, 2024 at 12:00 P.M. – July 19, 2024 at 12:00 P.M.

**Buncombe County Board of Education:**

## Where do I file?

## What are the qualifications?

- Must be a registered voter of the county.
- Must be at least 21 years old on Election Day.
- Where there is a district, must also reside within that district.
- Buncombe County School Board: must be a resident of the district in which you are filing.
- City of Asheville, Asheville School Board, Biltmore Forest, Black Mountain & Montreat: must be a resident within the municipal corporate limits.

## What do I need to bring?

- A valid NC driver license or photo ID, payment method for filing fee (cash, check, cashier's check, or money order), any completed campaign finance documents.

## Campaign Finance Information

All candidates are required to open a candidate committee. A candidate committee is required to register within 10 days of:

1. Receiving money or anything of value in support of the campaign; or
2. Spending money in support of the campaign; or
3. Giving consent for anyone else to receive money or spend money for the purpose of bringing about that individual's nomination or election for office; or
4. Filing a notice of candidacy.
