
WHEREAS, the county board's proposal is subject to approval by the Executive Director of the State Board of Elections; and,



Resolution 09112018A-Permanent location move of Precinct 20.1

Current location: First Congregational Church, 20 Oak Street, Asheville

Proposed location: Buncombe County Administration Building, 200 College Street, Asheville

- First Congregational Church is no longer willing to serve as a voting location.
- There is no charge for the use of the Buncombe County training room and the facility is ADA compliant. It is located next door to current voting location.
- The City of Asheville will reserve on-street parking for voters.
- Voters will receive two mailed notices of the new location as well as the location of the reserved parking spots.
- 1,159 total voters. **ED 2014 turnout-211. ED 2016 turnout-171.**

Resolution 09112018B-Permanent location move of Precinct 52.1

Current location: Leicester School, 31 Gilbert Road, Leicester

Proposed location: Leicester Library, 1561 Alexander Road, Leicester

- Leicester School is not an adequate voting site due to limited parking, very small room, and the student pick up and drop off significantly hinders voters.
- Leicester Library will be an early voting site this year and it is a familiar location in the community. It is ADA compliant and there is no charge for use. It is 1 mile from the current voting location.
- 3,832 total voters. **ED 2014 turnout-623. ED 2016 turnout-541.**

Resolution 09112018C-Permanent location move of Precinct 51.2 (pending site visit)

Current location: North Windy Ridge School, 20 Doan Road, Weaverville

Proposed location: Brookstone Baptist Church, 90 Griffee Road, Weaverville

- North Windy Ridge School is not an adequate voting site due to limited parking, very small room, and the bus parking is in the same lot as voter parking which hinders voters during student pick up and drop off times.
- Brookstone Baptist is .4 miles from N. Windy Ridge School.
- 2,090 total voters. **ED 2014 turnout-445. ED 2016 turnout-400.**




