The polls were opened at 6:30am. The scheduled meeting of the Buncombe County Board of Elections was called to order at 2:14pm on June 23, 2020, at 77 McDowell Street, Asheville, NC 28801.

In response to the COVID-19 threat and NC Stay at Home Order, the board meeting was held with limited in-person Board members and staff. The Board members and staff, along with the public, were in attendance over a virtual public access site hosted through the Public Teams meeting app. Directions on how to attend this virtual meeting were provided to the public on the Buncombe BOE website.

**Item One – Office Update**

Director Duncan gave the following updates:

- 10AM Total was 1,635 voters

## Item Two –Consideration of Absentee Ballot Applications Civilian, Overseas and Military

Absentee process has been modified to adhere to social distancing and maintaining PPE protocol to keep all Board members and staff safe.

- Staff member Johnston presented 2 overseas absentee ballots which will need duplication for they were emailed, and 23 civilian absentee applications containing ballots to be reviewed.
  - Board members divided into two bipartisan teams to review and approve the absentee ballot applications.
    - After the bipartisan Board team approval, the ballot was passed on to the bipartisan four-member ballot duplicating team. The team consisted of the following staff members: Daphne Young, Joan Merrill, Kevin Roberts, and Corinne Duncan.
    - Chairman Quinn inquired whether all calls and marks were clearly heard and seen, and the duplication team answered affirmatively.
  - Chairman Quinn inquired as to the SBOE directives on resending ballots to voters that have submitted incomplete absentee ballot applications. Staff member Johnston explained the SBOE has advised to reach out to these voters and resend a ballot if there is any possibility the newly completed ballot can be returned to BOE by the deadline. Staff is very diligent in following this guideline.
  - Member Block asked staff about the number of County employees who participating in work exchange at the voting locations on Election Day. Director Duncan reported that there are 13 work exchange county employees working at the voting locations and an additional 12 working in the evening helping with Election Day materials return.
  - Member Block expressed concern regarding the WAZE map phone app in not showing BOE's main office as 77 McDowell St. as the first choice when searching for Buncombe County Board of Elections. Google maps does seem to provide the correct main office location. She is wondering if Buncombe County has a way to address this issue.
  - Staff member Johnston presented the Absentee pollbooks for One-Stop/Early Voting for the time from 2PM until poll closing at 3PM on June 20, 2020 (63 Voters).
    - The Board signed these pollbooks.
  - The Board verified the sealed polybag containing the 23 original civilian absentee ballots and 2 overseas ballots.
  - The Board signed the Executed Absentee Ballot list audit log for the 23 civilian absentee ballots and 2 overseas ballots.
- Chairman Quinn motioned to approve the 23 civilian absentee ballots. The Board approved the absentee ballots unanimously.
- Chairman Quinn motioned to approve the 2 overseas ballots as duplicated. The Board approved the absentee ballots unanimously.




No questions or comments were submitted by virtual attendees.
