


 After clicking the link for the Teams Live event (available on our website), your browser will open to the page shown below.

- Click the white 'Watch on the web instead' button below the graphic of the four people.




 Your browser will then take you to a page that has the image displayed above in the center of the page. Click the purple 'Join anonymously' link below the 'Sign in' button.
