 REMOVE "CONTRACTOR'S POLLUTION LIABILITY" CLAUSE AND REQUIREMENTS FROM CONTRACT.
- **AS.02 00004 FORM OF PROPOSAL:** REVISED BID FORM WITH UPDATED LINE ITEMS FOR MATERIALS ESCALATION. REFER TO REVISED ESCALATION CLAUSE BELOW FOR FURTHER INFORMATION.
- AS.03 BID CLARIFICATION: ROOFING MATERIALS COST ESCALATION FACTOR CLAUSE Change Escalation Clause from Addendum #2 to read as follows: (Bold text indicates a change from the previous requirement outlined in Addendum #2.) Struckthrough text indicates a removal from the previous requirement outlined in Addendum #2.)

Price Escalation Clause for Roofing Materials. Prime Bidders shall include a fixed escalation factor as a line item to the bid proposal form. This escalation factor shall be reflected as a percentage increase over 2021 Quarter 4 prices for <u>roofing membrane</u>, <u>fasteners and adhesives</u> and <u>roofing insulation materials</u> in response to unpredictable market conditions, uncommitted pricing from manufacturers and varied availability of material supplies which are influencing costs and project schedules industry wide. This

clause acknowledges that this escalation factor may vary between bidders based on contractor preferred manufacturer source of materials and anticipated lead times. Escalation percentages should be recorded on the bid form individually for the base bid and each alternate, as availability of materials may vary between manufacturers and roofing products.

Additionally, the prime bidder shall indicate a bid price for roofing materials as stated above on the bid form to establish the baseline for which to apply the escalation when final pricing from manufacturers can be confirmed. This cost is to be for the materials as specified for the base bid. Material costs, while recorded separately for the base bid, should also be reflected in the stated base bid amount on the proposal form. For the purposes of bidding, it is assumed that the alternate prices quoted on the bid form primarily reflect material costs only as indicated in the specification language for each alternate. The contractor shall supply back-up manufacturer's documentation, invoices, manufacturer quotes or other papers to the Owner upon request attached to the bid for base bid and all alternates. Documentation is to be presented on official manufacturer's paperwork, letterhead or invoice. Further decumentation will later be required by the Owner for any accepted bid alternates.

This escalation percentage and bid price applies to the reofing materials as stated above only, and will not be used as factor for awarding the project based on the lowest responsible bid. The lowest responsible bidder will be determined as follows:

Base Bid + (Materials Costs * Escalation Percentage) = Low Bid

or

Base Bid + Selected Alternate + (Selected Alternate Materials cost * Alternate Escalation Percentage) = Low Bid

The Owner will determine which, if any, alternate to accept based on any combination of material availability, schedule impact, overall project costs and available funding.

Should there be an increase in the price of roofing materials that are purchased for use in this project after the execution of the contract that exceeds the baseline costs provided on the bid form, the Owner agrees to pay the actual increase in cost of materials, not to exceed the declared escalation percentage included as part of the submitted bid. The contractor shall supply back-up documentation, invoices, manufacturer purchase orders and other papers to the Owner to verify the cost increase.

1. Is there some assurance that we can (or should) offer in case the contract is canceled: reimbursement of any cancellation fees or bond expenses? IN THE EVENT THAT THE PROJECT HAS BEEN CANCELLED ALL CONTRACTUAL REQUIREMENTS WILL BE MET.

- 2. Can EPS insulation be glued for a fully adhered system? EPS IS NOT LONGER CONSIDERED AN ACCEPTIBLE SUBSTITUTION FOR POLYISO INSULATION.
- 3. How are we choosing the low bidder? Base bid? Base Bid and Alternates selected? Is the escalation included? Do we have different escalations for different alternates? SEE THE ATTACHED ESCALATION CLAUSE INFORMATION FOR FURTHER **EXPLANATION (AS.03).**
- 4. Can we include material costs for edge metals in the escalation clause for roofing materials? NO. ONLY ROOFING MATERIALS ASSOCIATED WITH THE MEMBRANE, INSULATION AND FASTENING SYSTEM.
- 5. Please confirm that "Pollution insurance" is truly required for this project. It will add 13K to the cost. The only time we have previously needed it was for a water treatment project. POLUTION INSURANCE WILL NOT BE REQUIRED.
- 6. Are the any specs for the EPS. Most manufactures will require a minimum 125# density. **REFER TO POLYISO SPECS IN SECTION 075426**

The bidder further proposes and agrees hereby to commence work under this contract on a date to be specified in a written order of the designer and shall fully complete all work thereunder within the time specified in the Supplementary General Conditions Article 23. Applicable liquidated damages amount is also stated in the Supplementary General Conditions Article 23.

MINORITY BUSINESS PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

<u>Provide with the bid</u> - Under GS 143-128.2(c) the undersigned bidder shall identify <u>on its bid</u> (Identification of Minority Business Participation Form) the minority businesses that it will use on the project with the total dollar value of the bids that will be performed by the minority businesses. <u>Also</u> list the good faith efforts (Affidavit A) made to solicit minority participation in the bid effort.

NOTE: A contractor that performs all of the work with its <u>own workforce</u> may submit an Affidavit (**B**) to that effect in lieu of Affidavit (**A**) required above. The MB Participation Form must still be submitted even if there is zero participation.

<u>After the bid opening</u> - The Owner will consider all bids and alternates and determine the lowest responsible, responsive bidder. Upon notification of being the apparent low bidder, the bidder shall then file within 72 hours of the notification of being the apparent lowest bidder, the following:

An Affidavit (**C**) that includes a description of the portion of work to be executed by minority businesses, expressed as a percentage of the total contract price, which is <u>equal to or more than the 10% goal</u> established. This affidavit shall give rise to the presumption that the bidder has made the required good faith effort and Affidavit **D** is not necessary;

* OR *

<u>If less than the 10% goal</u>, Affidavit (**D**) of its good faith effort to meet the goal shall be provided. The document must include evidence of all good faith efforts that were implemented, including any advertisements, solicitations and other specific actions demonstrating recruitment and selection of minority businesses for participation in the contract.

Note: Bidders must always submit <u>with their bid</u> the Identification of Minority Business Participation Form listing all MB contractors, <u>vendors and suppliers</u> that will be used. If there is no MB participation, then enter none or zero on the form. Affidavit A **or** Affidavit B, as applicable, also must be submitted with the bid. Failure to file a required affidavit or documentation with the bid or after being notified apparent low bidder is grounds for rejection of the bid.
