RE: Health alert from the Buncombe County Department of Health

Construction at 40 Coxe and Temporary Move of Some Health Services

Buncombe County will begin construction of an addition to the current 40 Coxe Avenue location in downtown Asheville in early April. During construction, this will mean changes in parking and the entryway at 40 Coxe Avenue and the temporary relocation of immunizations and clinical services to 53 S. French Broad Avenue. Construction is expected to be completed within the next two years and at that time, health services that were relocated will be moved back to 40 Coxe Avenue.

Until then, we would like your help to get the word out about these changes to help reduce confusion about where people should go to get services.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

Inform visitors that:

- Due to construction at 40 Coxe Avenue, some Health Department services are moving temporarily to 53 S. French Broad Avenue. Services moving include Immunizations and Foreign Travel Services, Family Planning, STD Clinic, Breast and Cervical Cancer Program, and TB (Tuberculosis) Services. Parking for Health Department Services is available in front and behind the building at 53 S. French Broad Avenue. Those with appointments and walk-ins can begin receiving Services at 53 S. French Broad Avenue on the afternoon of March 31.
- Economic Services will stay at Coxe Avenue. The Women, Infants and Children (WIC) and Child Care Subsidy programs will also remain at Coxe until an anticipated move in May to a location yet to be determined.
- A new parking lot for visitors will be next to the downtown bus station across the street from 40 Coxe Avenue. The front entrance will be located on Coxe Avenue directly across from the bus station.
