NOT JUST A LITTLE RASH

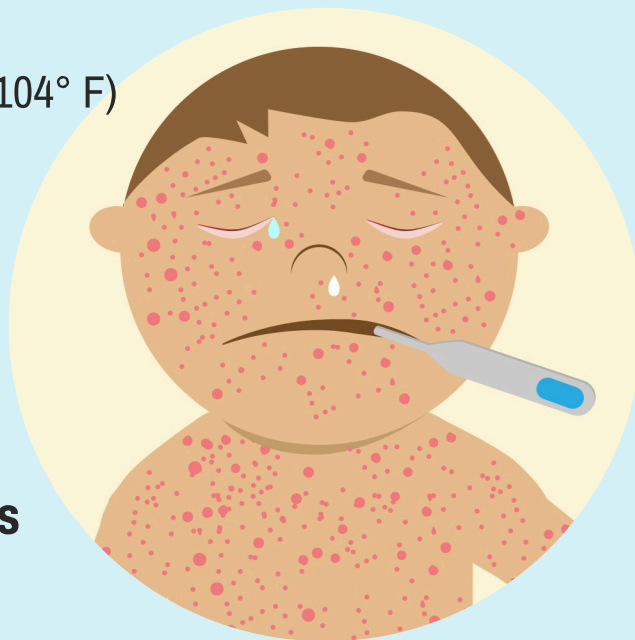
Measles can be dangerous,

About 1 in 4 people who get
the measles will be hospitalized.

MEASLES SYMPTOMS INCLUDE

- **High Fever**
(may spike to more than 104° F)
- **Red, Watery Eyes**
- **Cough**
- **Runny Nose**
- **Rash breaks out 3-5
days after symptoms
begin**



YOU HAVE THE POWER TO PROTECT YOUR CHILD.

protection** against measles.

Make sure they get the **measles-mumps-rubella
(MMR) vaccine** according to CDC's recommended
immunization schedule.
