NOT JUST A LITTLE RASH


Measles can be dangerous, especially for babies, young children, & pregnant women.



About 1 in 4 people who get the measles will be hospitalized.

MEASLES SYMPTOMS INCLUDE

- High Fever (may spike to more than 104° F)
- Red, Watery Eyes
- Cough
- Runny Nose
- Rash breaks out 3-5 days after symptoms begin



YOU HAVE THE POWER TO PROTECT YOUR CHILD.

Provide your children with **safe** and **long lasting protection** against measles.

Make sure they get the **measles-mumps-rubella** (MMR) vaccine according to CDC's recommended immunization schedule.
