

Justice Services Data Report-Jail Population


Hannah Legerton

- May 2020-July 2020- Reduced population by 40% and was able to close the Annex portion of the detention facility.
- October 2020-July 2021- Sustained 15% reduction
- Summer of 2021- started moving back to capacity
- Jail population increased due to increase in length of stay and now being close to capacity.
- DK mentioned that Recurring data points will be presented to group in the future and ask the group for any suggestions regarding the data pull.
- DK also mentioned there had been no increase in Recidivism based on the reduction during the Pandemic.
