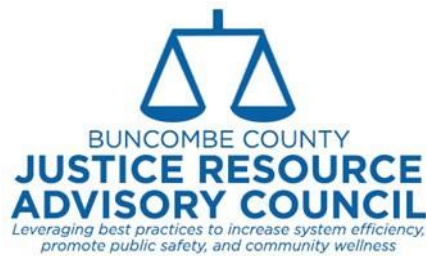
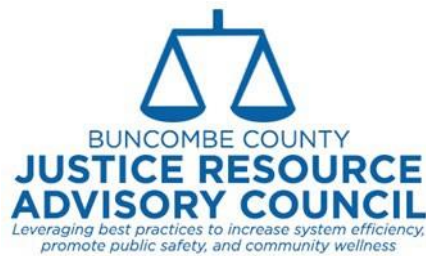


- **Welcome:** Dakisha (DK) Wesley

    - Policy Solutions – Improving court appearance and Improving response to missed appearances
    - Discussion of text message reminders for court; law enforcement “palm cards;” transportation support, reducing wait times for hearings with block scheduling; formalizing and expanding options for virtual court
