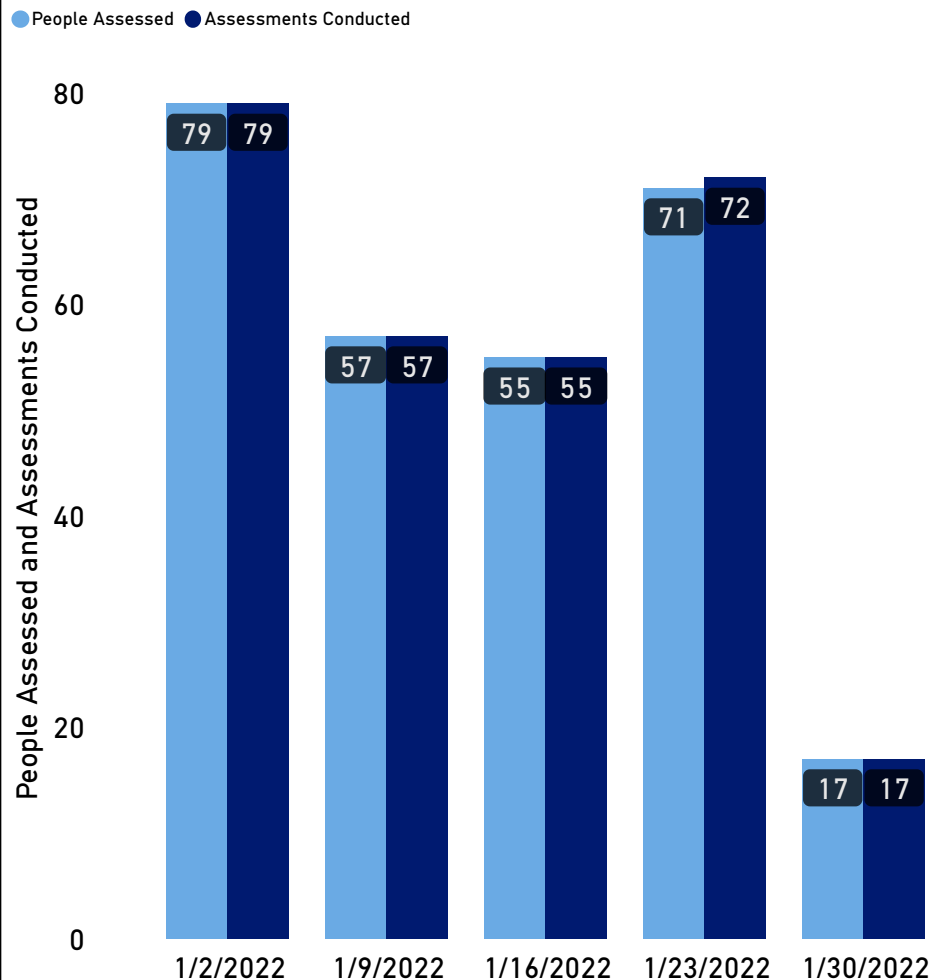

Volume of PSAs & People Assessed by Week

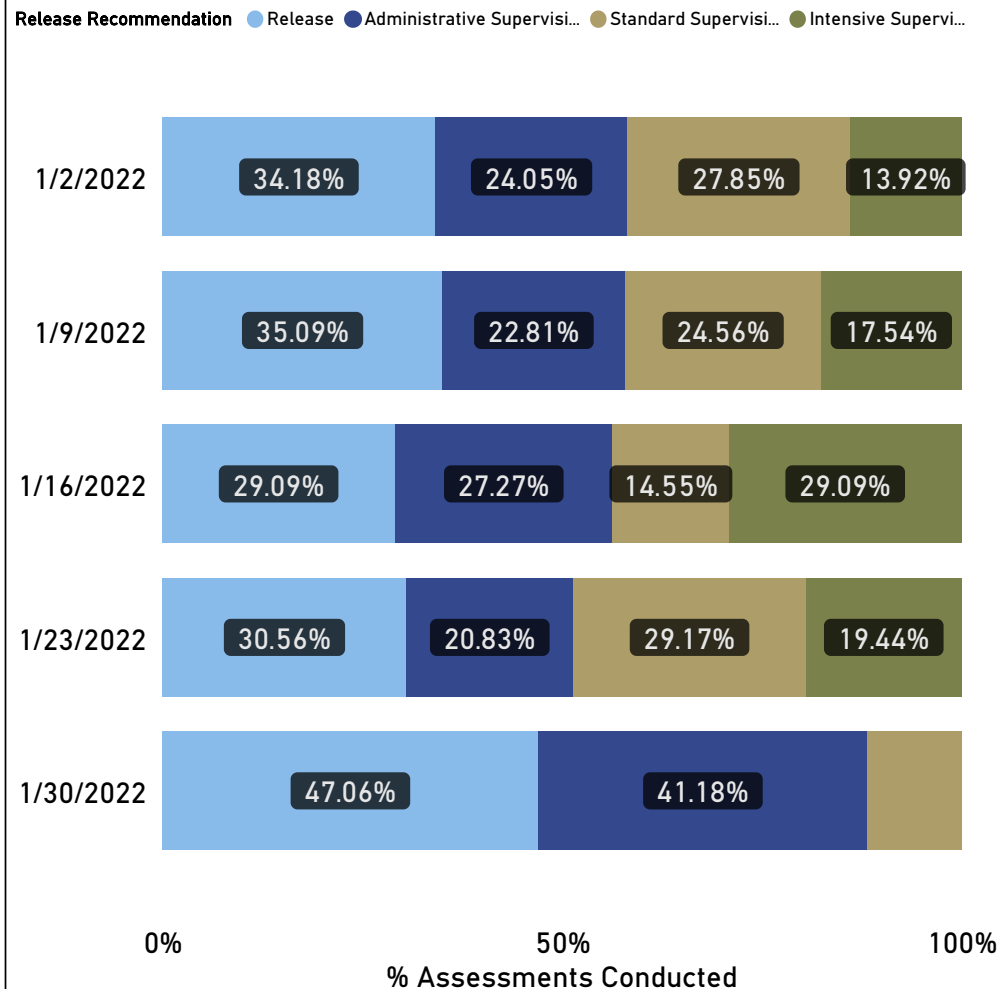

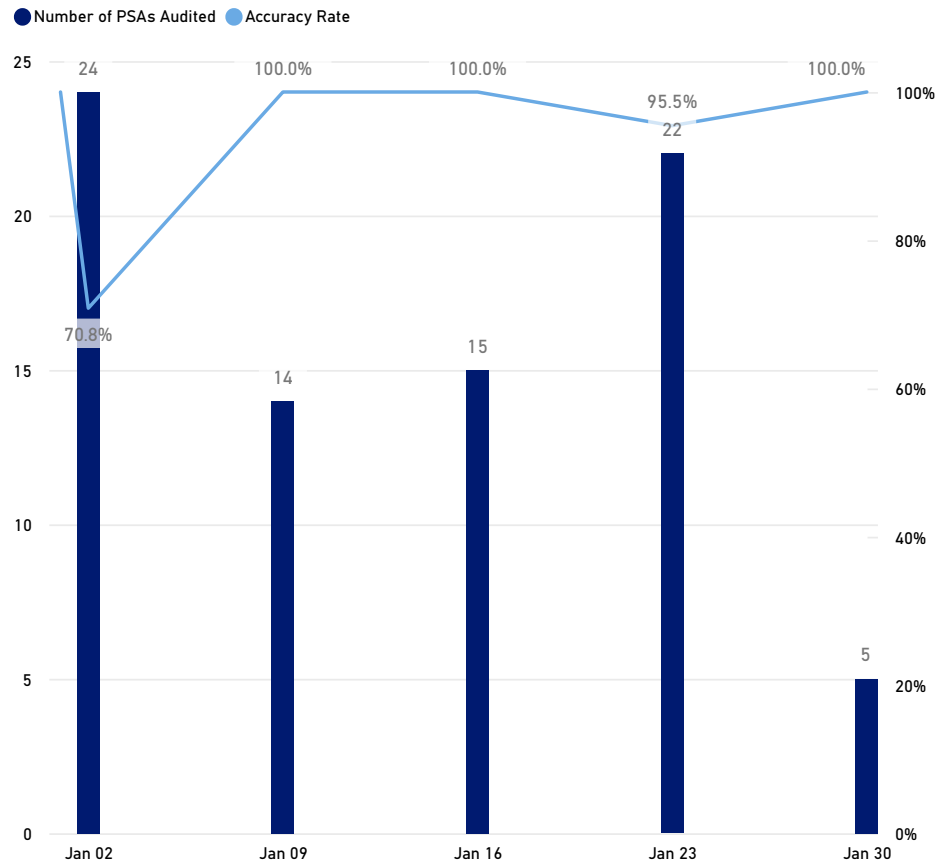

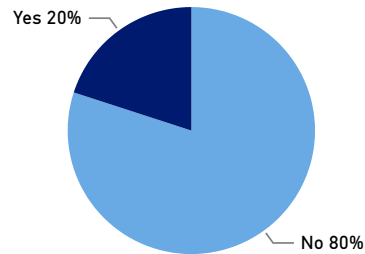

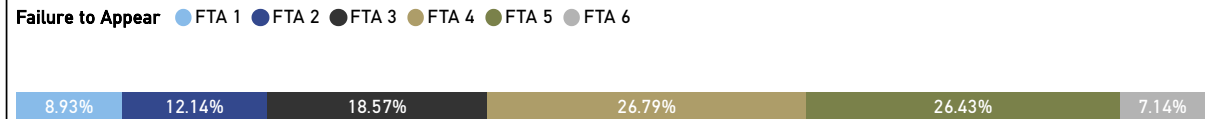

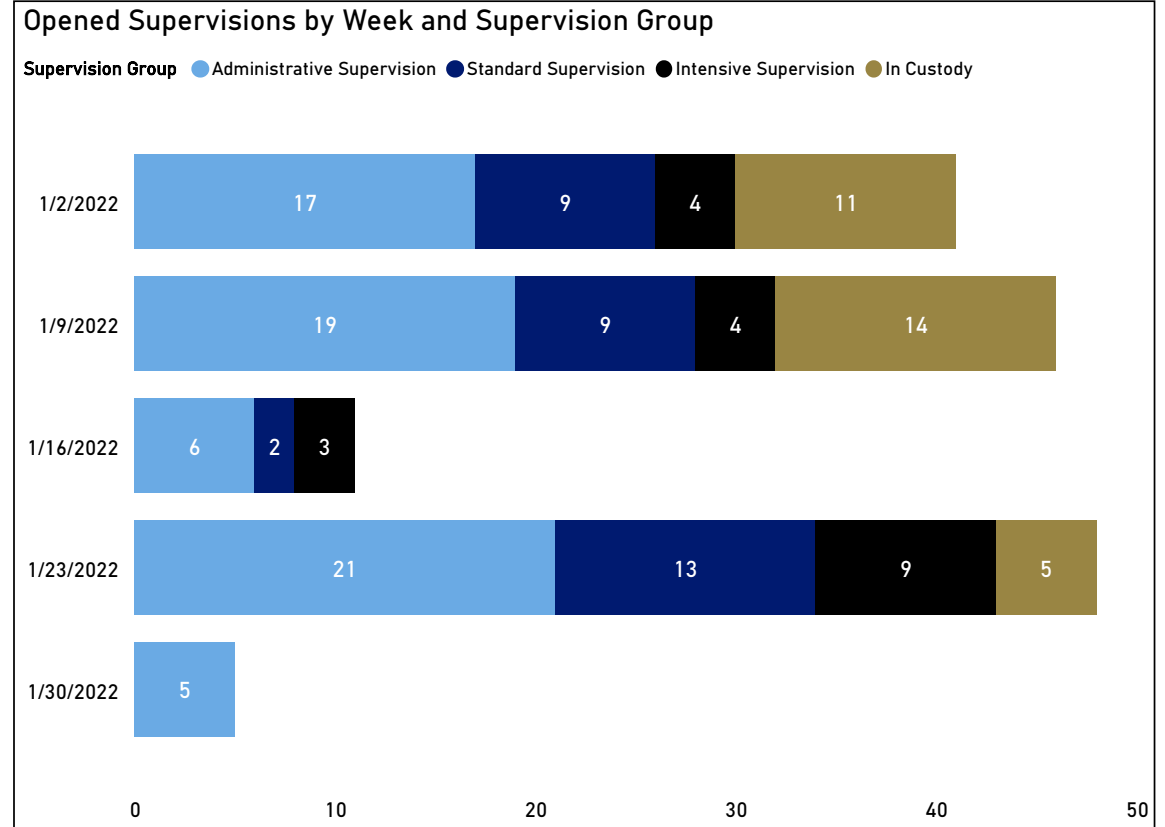
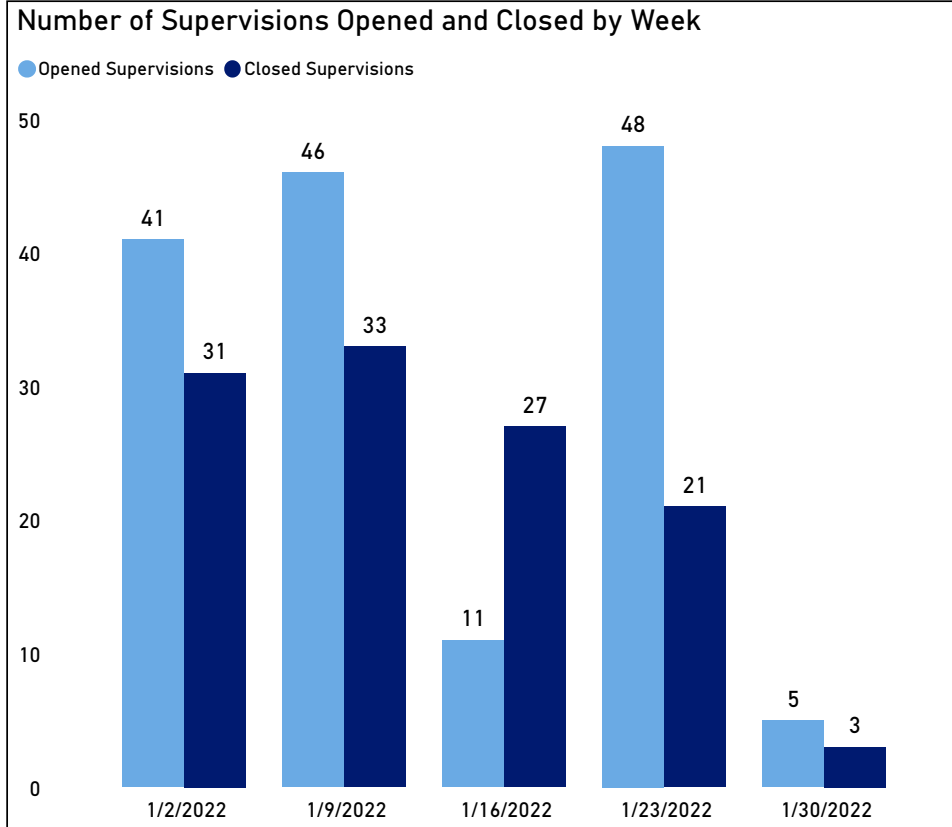


## January Assignments and Closures

A person can be referred to pretrial supervision by a district or superior court judge. They can be assigned to supervision on more than one charge or might not be referred to supervision for all pending charges. For the purposes of this report, a supervision is counted as one supervision regardless of the number of charges they have been referred to supervision for. For example, if a person has six pending charges in Buncombe County, and they have been referred to Pretrial on four of those charges, that is counted as one supervision.



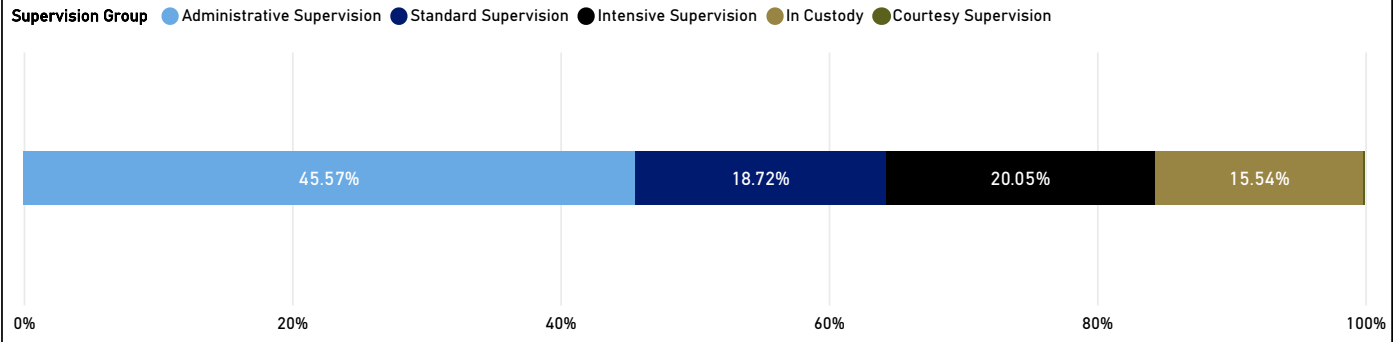

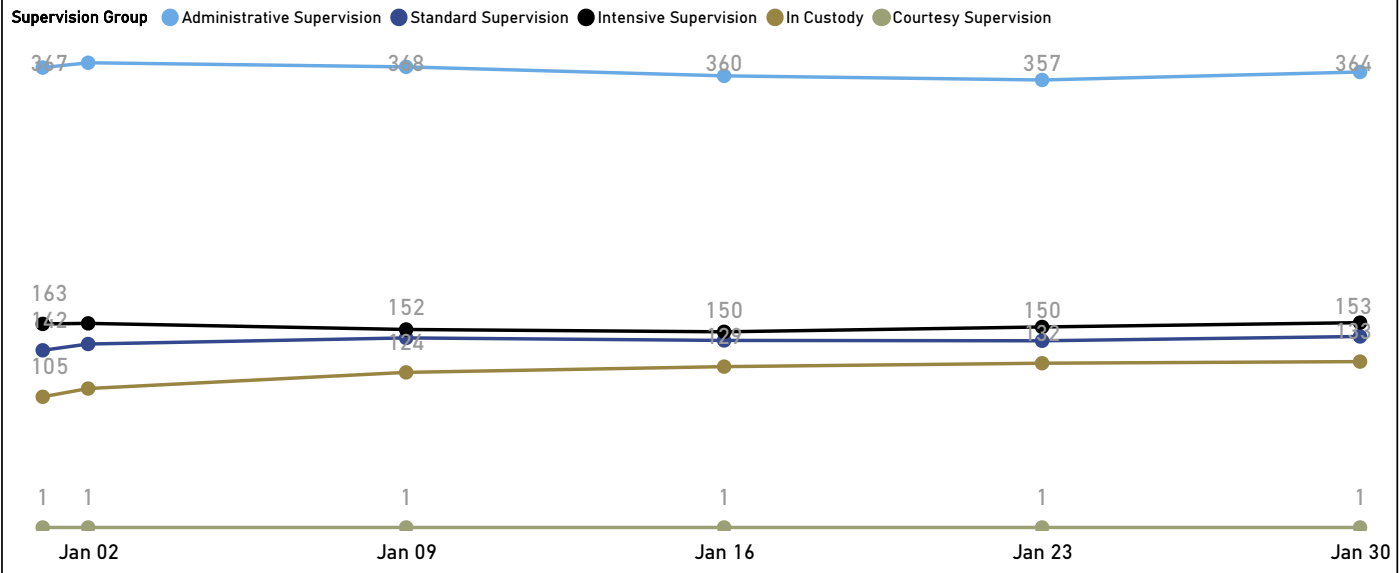

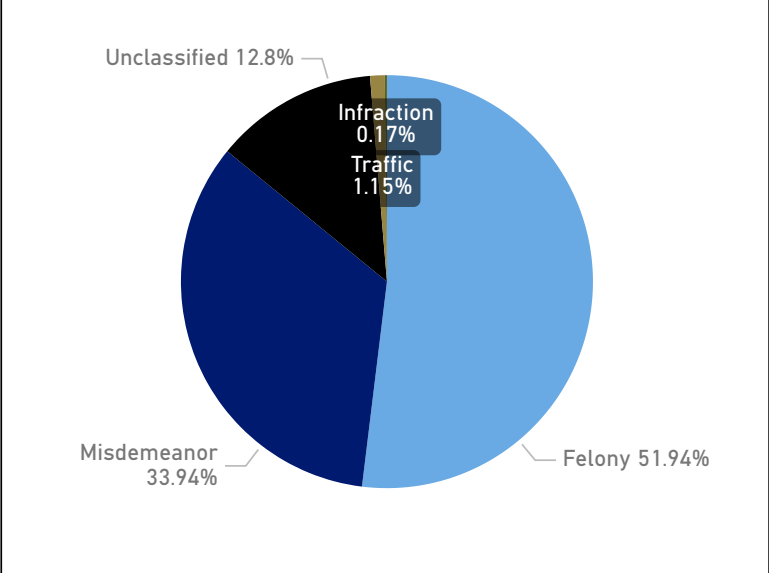
## Average Daily Caseload by Supervision Group

## Average Daily Caseload by Top Charge Type

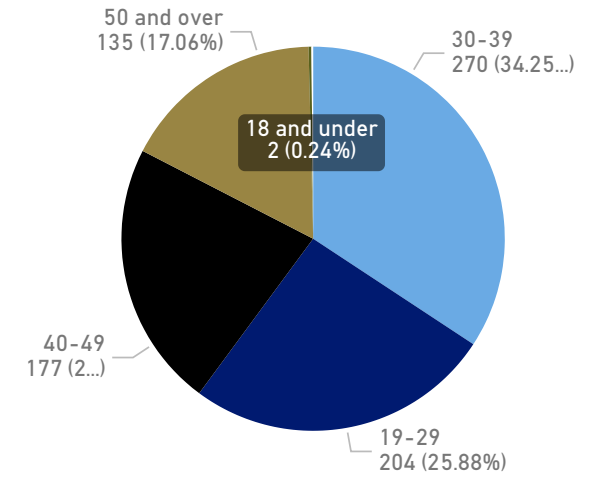

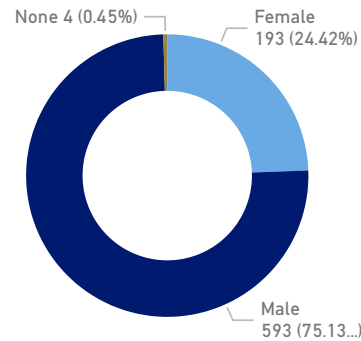

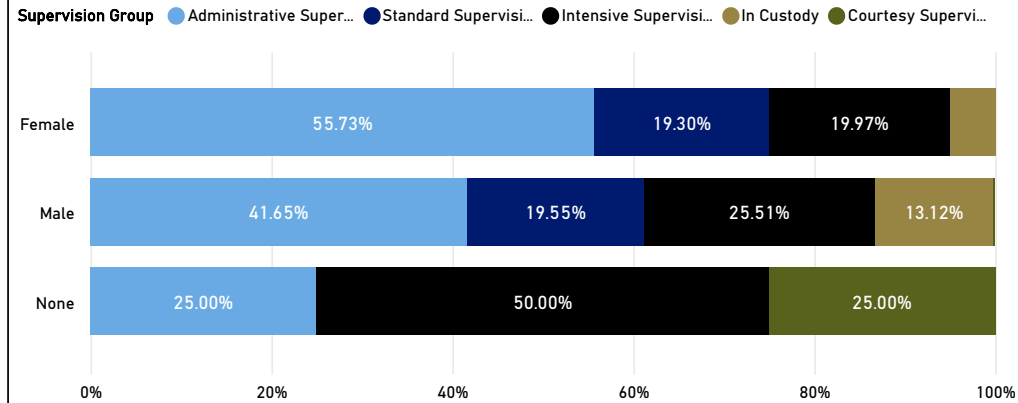
### By Age Group



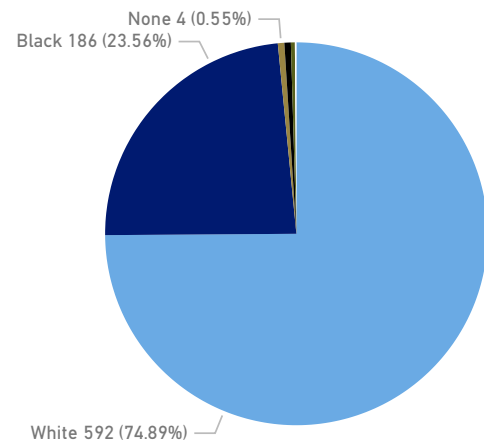
### By Gender



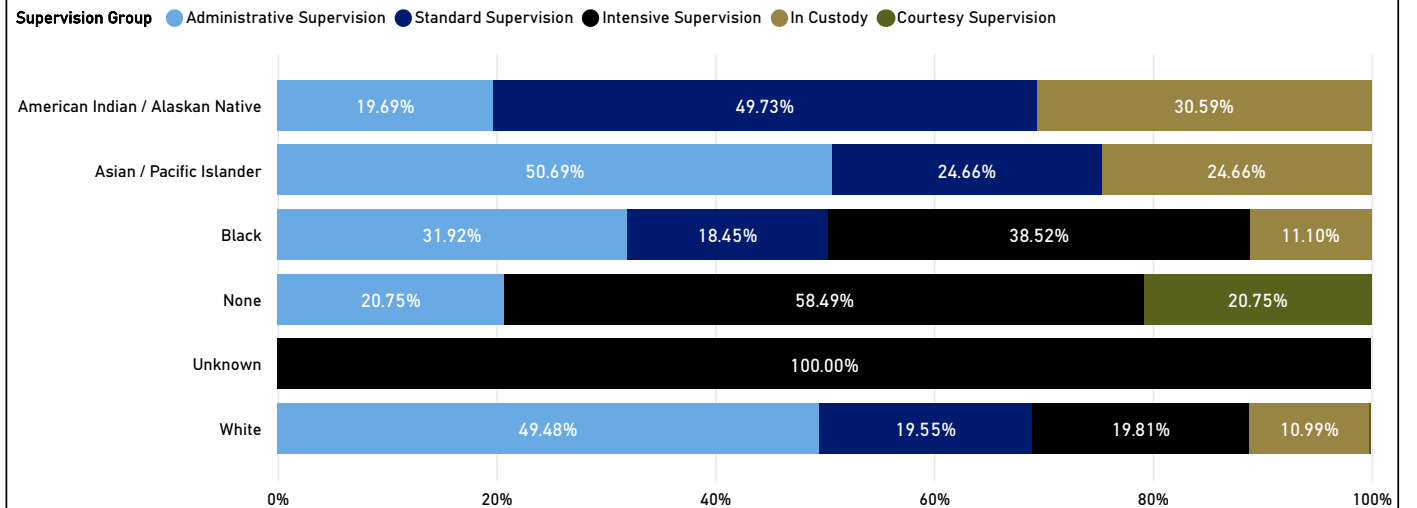

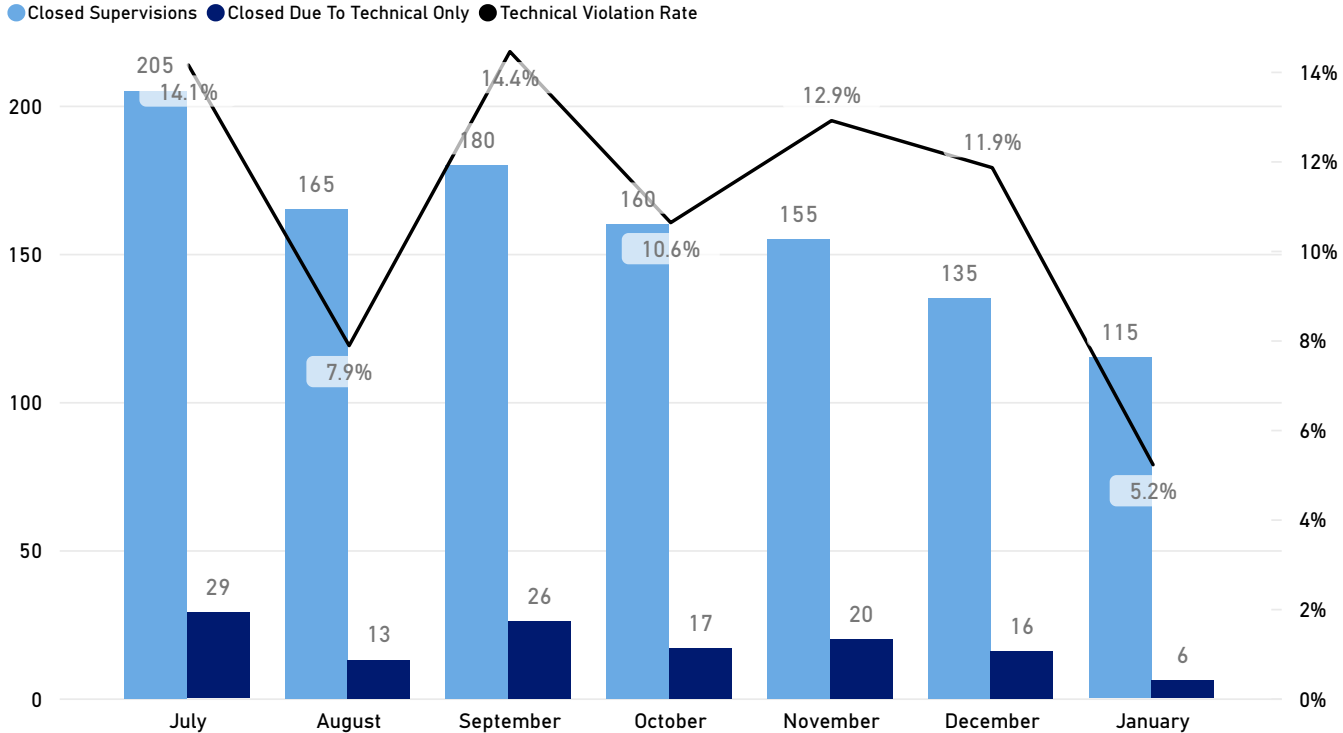

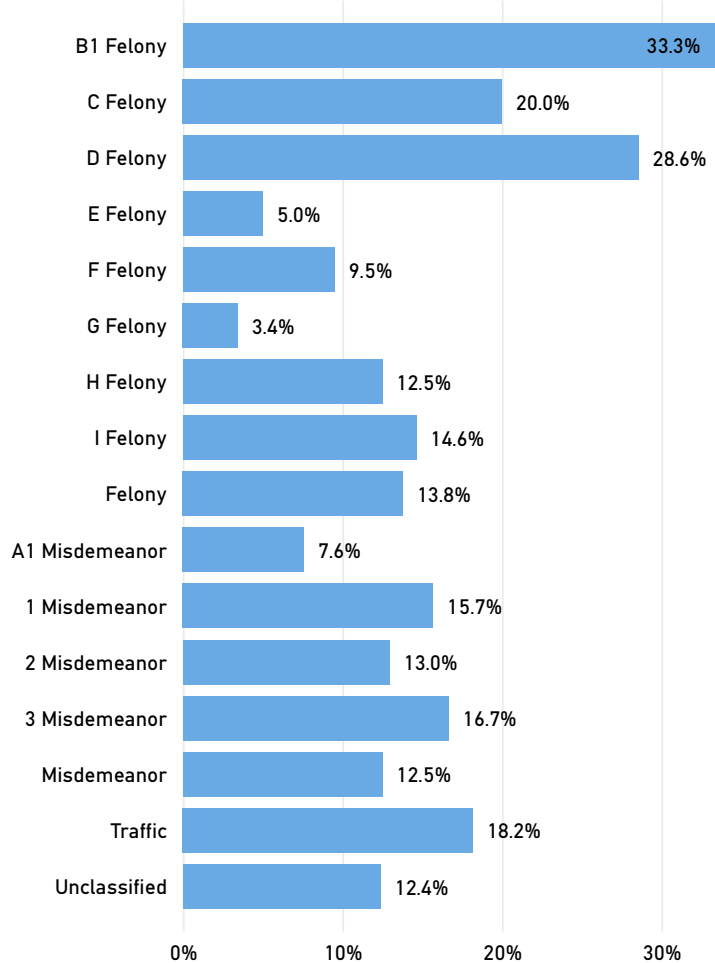

A closed supervision that is unsuccessful is counted as a technical violation if "technical violation" is the only disposition reason identified on the supervision.

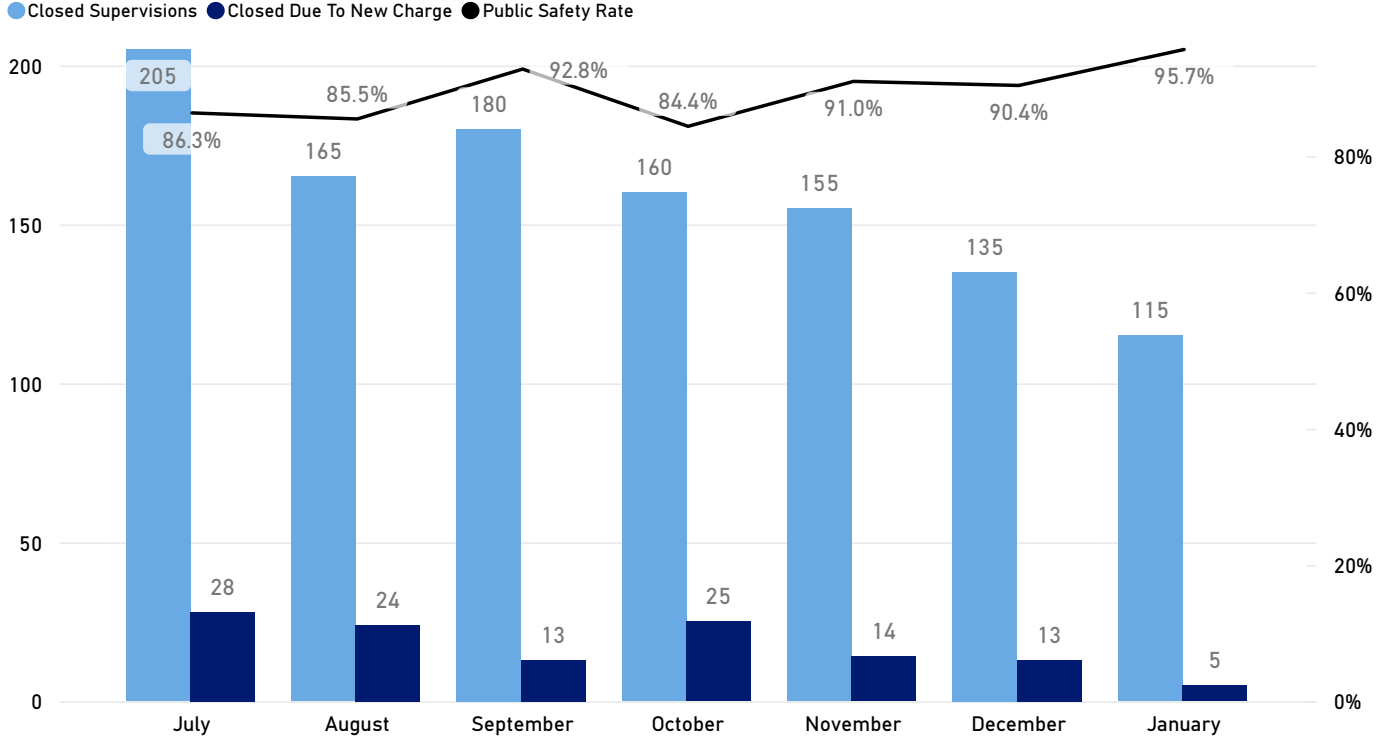

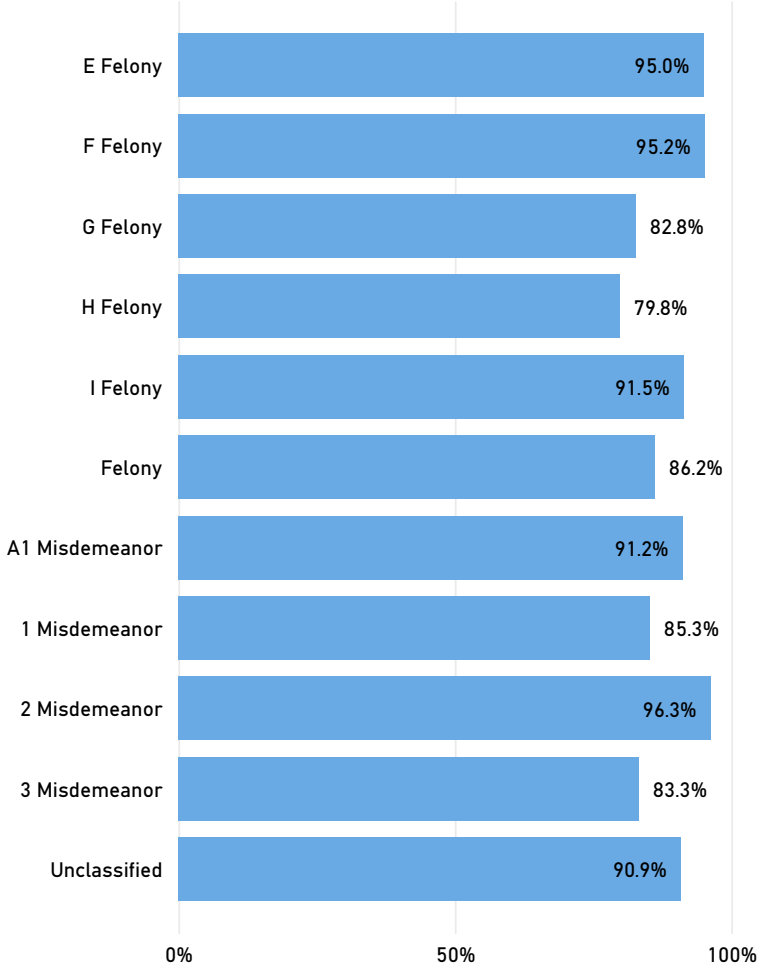

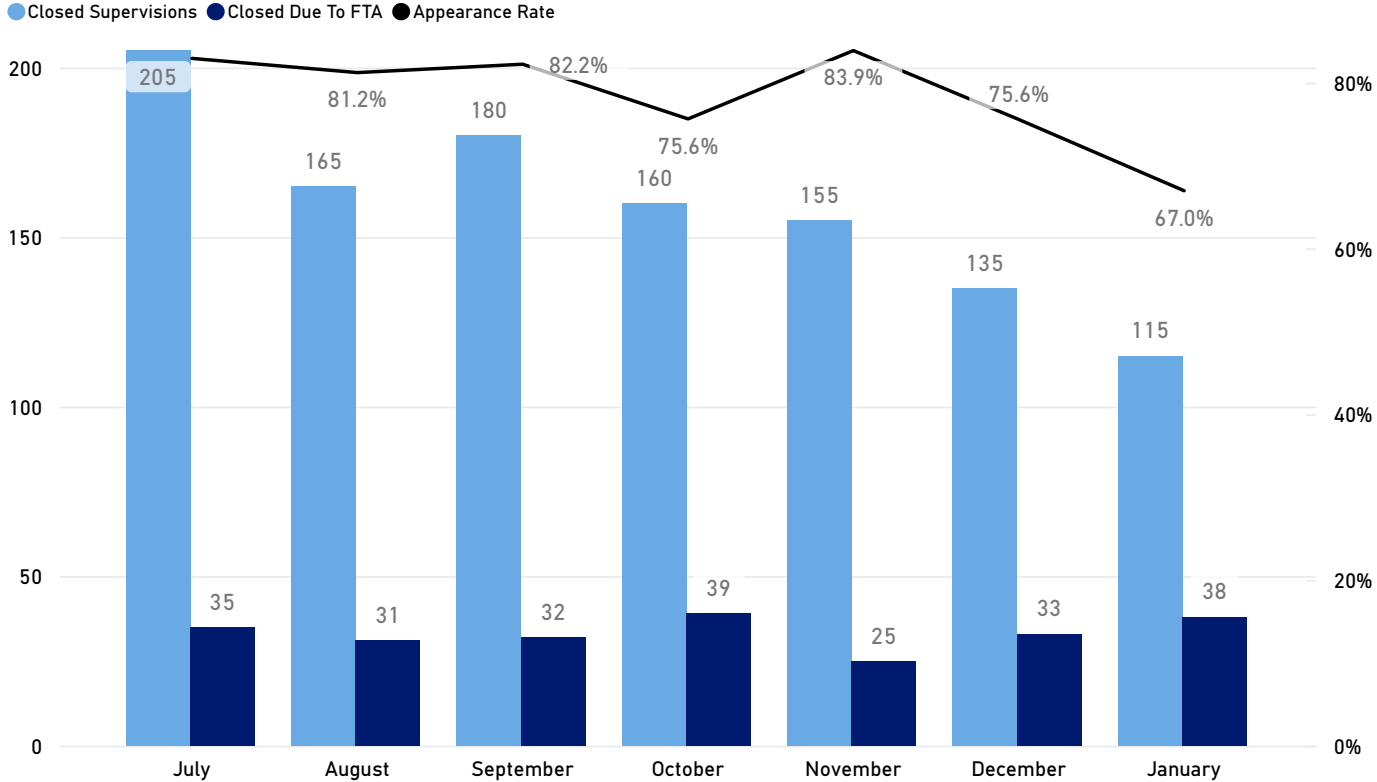

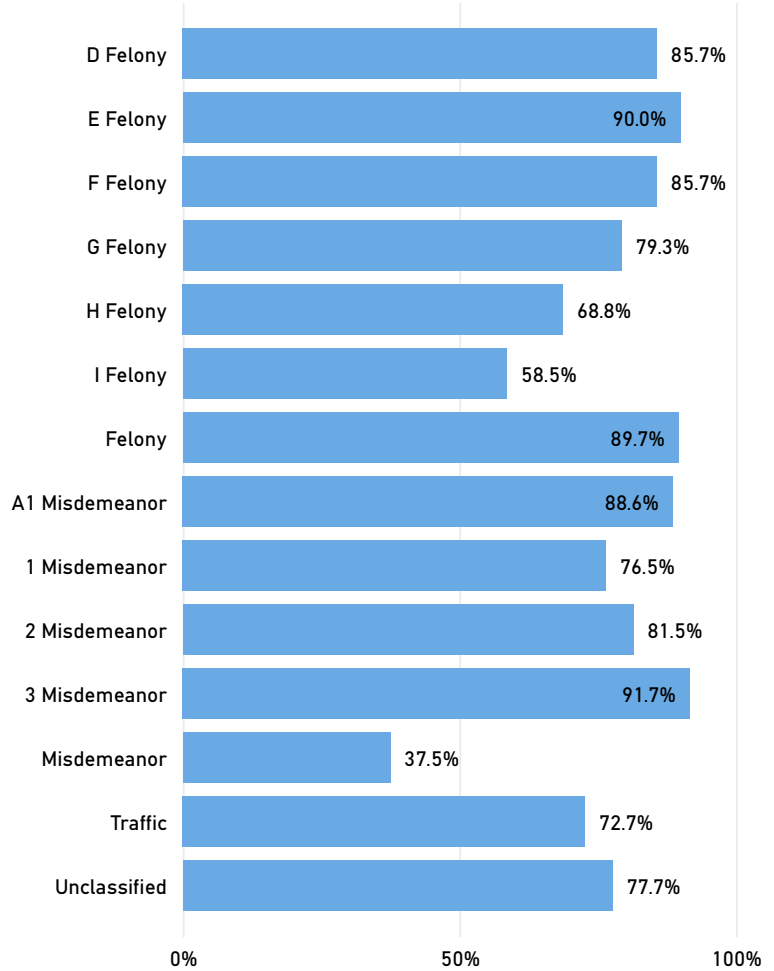

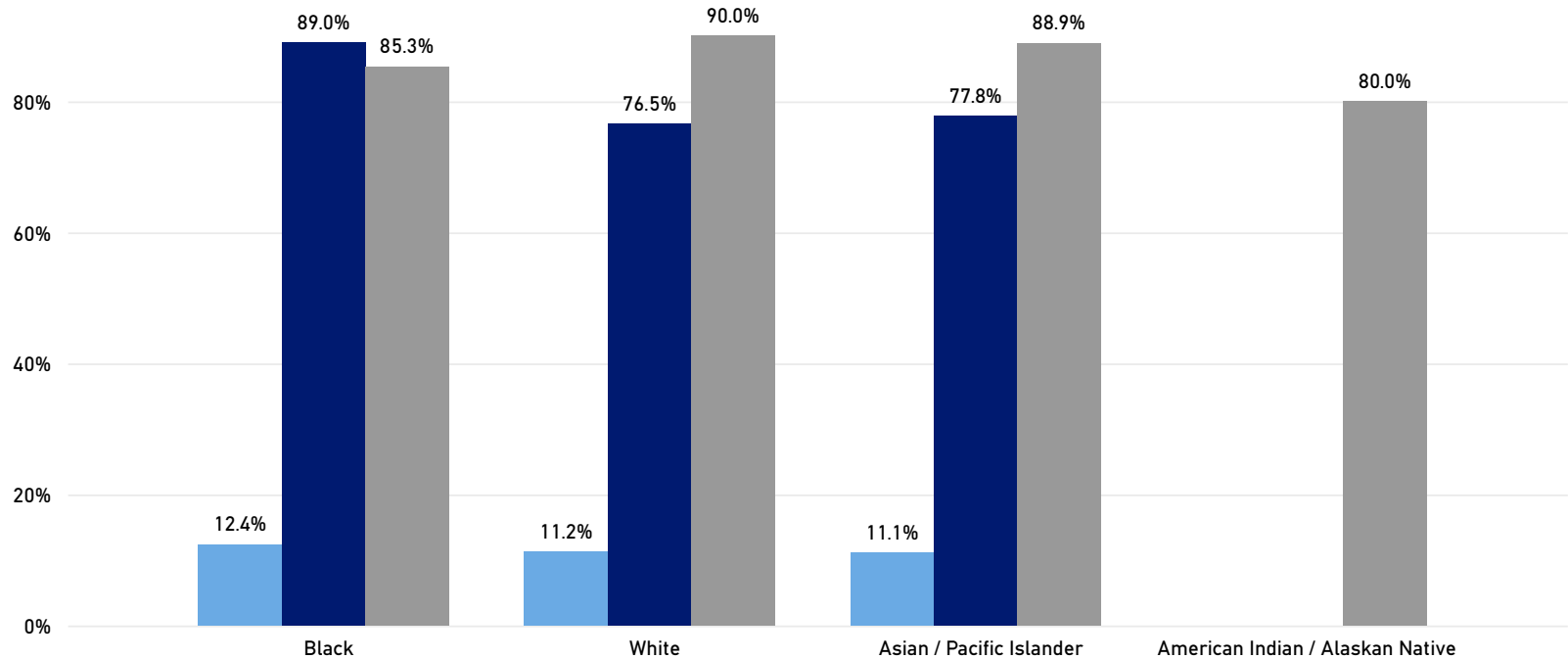

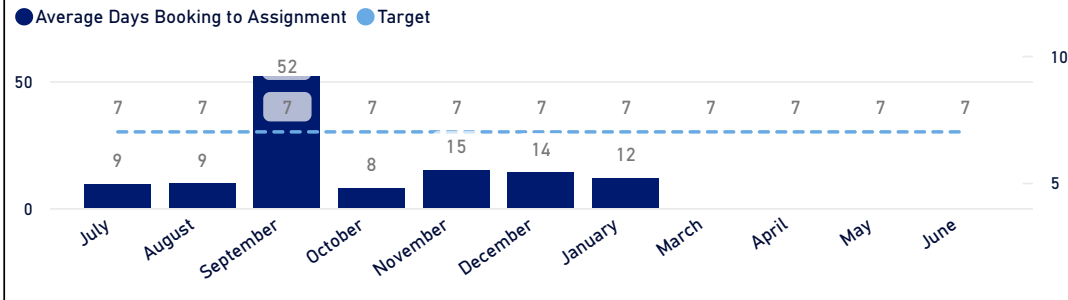

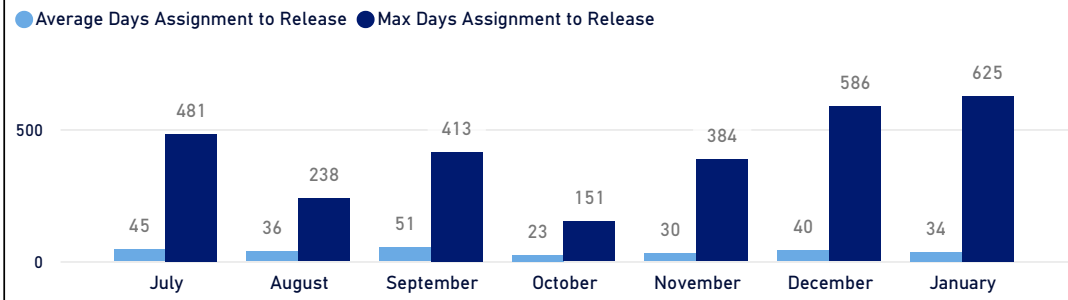

### Average Days Between Booking and Assignment by Month Assigned



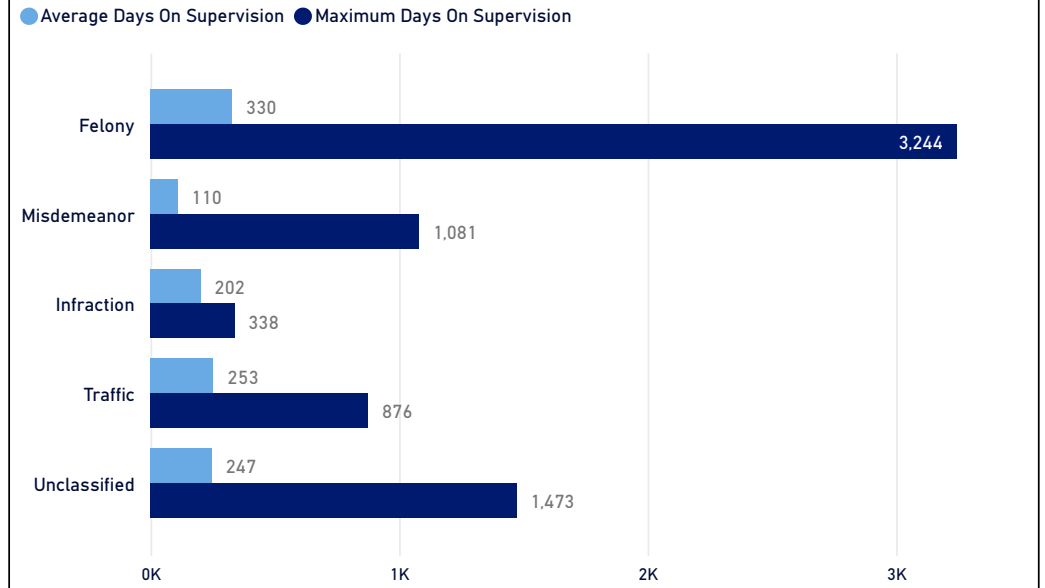
### Average Days Between Assignment and Release by Month Released
