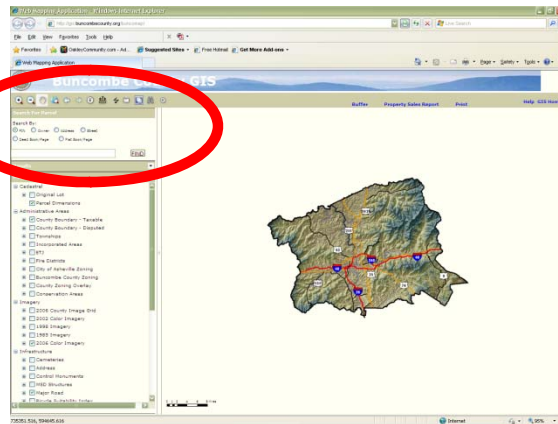


Accessing Flood Information on the Buncombe County GIS System

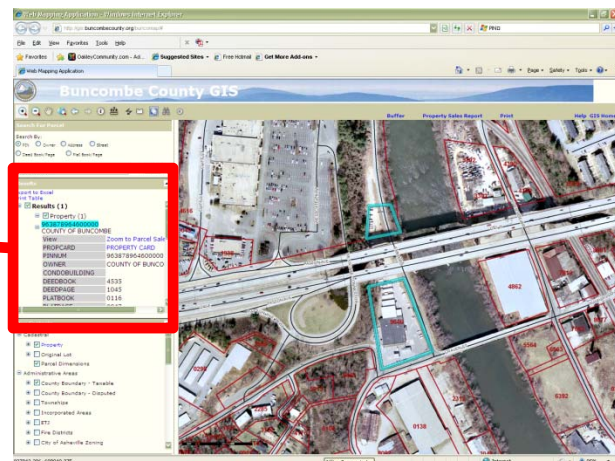
