Our minimum need is for a provider that can provide 25 hours of Licensed Counseling and 40 hours of Peer Support services.

(ie: no requirements for psychiatric care, SAIOP, etc.) If no, please explain which additional services clients would need to engage in to receive the level of service we are seeking?
- 5) Is your agency able and willing to prescribe MAT to individuals at this level of service, without any barriers regarding continuation or induction? If no, is your agency able and willing to work with a local MAT provider in coordination of care, with the Peer Support as lead in care management?
