A. Purpose:

Buncombe County is seeking firms interested in providing services for a space plan and expansion design for the Sheriff's office at Leicester Crossing.

B. Project Summary:

The Buncombe County Sheriff's office currently occupies approximately 8,000 square feet of the facility at 339 New Leicester Highway (Leicester Crossing). There is approximately 7,000 square feet of unused space at the facility that was vacated by a previous tenant. The goal of this project is to provide Buncombe County with a space plan for the area and a design for the expansion of the Sheriff's Departments operations at the facility. The project will include, but is not limited to the following components:

- Assist Buncombe County and the Sheriff's Department in evaluating the space and developing a plan for utilization.
- Design an expansion of the evidence storage and processing area.
- Design the addition of an emergency generator to provide backup power so that operations and security can continue when power outages occur.
- Design a Criminal Investigations Department (CID) area and office space so that detectives can examine, analyze, and log evidence securely and efficiently.
- Provide cost estimates for the project(s).
- Provide bid documents for the project(s).

C. Submission Requirements:

- Letter of Interest A letter of interest must be submitted giving the qualifications of the project team, including the firm history, individual resumes, current and completed projects over the last seven years.
 - Please provide a list of four completed projects which are relevant to the scope of the project as listed above and of similar size, scope and complexity.
 - Demonstrate success with similar projects for local and state governments, preferably within North Carolina.
 - Provide examples of the past experience of key members of the proposed team on the projects itemized regarding the above.
- Provide an organizational chart and resumes which will address the following:
 - Name the Principal in Charge, Project Manager, and other individuals to be assigned to the project, providing for each the number of years of service with the company, number of years of professional experience, and educational background inclusive of professional certifications (if a joint venture, please list the above for each firm to be involved). Please indicate the number of persons employed by each firm. If the firm has multiple offices, please also list the number of persons employed by each office location proposed to provide architectural services for this project.
 - For sub-consultants, inclusive of landscaping, surveying, engineering, civil
 engineering, or other key components, please list the names and addresses of
 each company, as well as the name of any individuals to be assigned to the
 project.

- Provide a list of the current workload of the firm(s), the individual workload of the Project Manager(s).
- Provide the office location(s) which will be handling the project.
