A. Purpose

Buncombe County anticipates the need of a licensed engineer to provide full set of designs, and construction project certification upon completion.

B. Submission Requirements

- Letter of Interest – A letter of interest must be submitted that includes the following:
 - Please list four completed conservation easement projects in Buncombe County carried out in the last five years;
 - Provide the number of years of professional experience, and educational background inclusive of professional certifications;
 - Provide the office location(s) which will be providing the services.
- Engineer shall meet the following criteria:
 - PE licensed in NC
 - Experience working on streambank stabilization and stream restoration
 - Experience with the permitting process for the construction they identify in their design
 - Have extensive experience with No rise/No impact studies and the associated software
 - Familiarity with NRCS standards/specification associated with this project and know how to design to meet them
- The selected firm will also be expected to provide all necessary information for permitting including no-rise no impact study for FEMA 100 year flood zone.

C. Qualifications

Buncombe County anticipates selecting multiple firms for the referenced work, followed by negotiations for service fees for the projects.
